1b. PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments at this time.

CLOSED SESSION

President Sugarman stated the Board would recess into closed session to discuss Public Employee Discipline, Dismissal, Release [Government Code Sections 54954.5(d), 54957].

OPEN SESSION

The Board returned to Open Session at 9:50 a.m. President Sugarman announced there was nothing to report from Closed Session.

CLOSED SESSION

The Board recessed into Closed Session at 10:05 a.m. and conducted Expulsion Hearing 00/01-01 pursuant to Education Code section 48900(c). The Board recessed into deliberation at 10:52 a.m.

OPEN SESSION

The Board returned to Open Session at 11:10 a.m. Moved by Ellen Ballard, seconded by Robert Fisler and carried 3-1 (Kim Guth voted "no") to suspend the expulsion for one semester and keep the student in his/her present school. Pursuant to Education Code section 48916, a rehabilitation plan is to be developed by the superintendent or designee and recommended for the student and the student's parents for completion during the period of the suspended expulsion.

CLOSED SESSION

The Board recessed into Closed Session at 11:20 a.m. and conducted Expulsion Hearing 00/01-02 pursuant to Education Code section 48900(c). The Board recessed into deliberation at 12:17 p.m.

OPEN SESSION

The Board returned to Open Session at 12:35 p.m. Moved by Ellen Ballard, seconded by Kim Guth and carried unanimously that the findings and conclusions of the Board be adopted and that the student be expelled from all the schools and programs of the District for the remainder of the semester in which the act occurred and the following semester. Pursuant to Education Code section 48916, a rehabilitation plan is to be developed by the superintendent or designee and recommended for the student and the student's parents for completion during the period of the suspended expulsion. The student may apply for readmission after June 14, 2001.

President Sugarman adjourned the meeting on October 18, 2000 at 12:38 p.m.
