### 2025-26 Dress Code & Uniform Policy

While attending school, all students must be in full uniform daily.\* As a school, we have chosen to represent ourselves professionally, with a polished and formal uniform. Our uniform reflects our pride and our respect for our school.

While specific guidelines are provided below it is important for students to develop an understanding of and adherence to the spirit and standards of professional dress. The policy below applies to students as they enter the school building and throughout the school day. If a student is out of uniform, they may be required to secure appropriate attire before attending class. Uniforms must be neat, and clean, and students should also practice good hygiene.

<p><b>Shirts</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid white button-down shirt with a sleeve, straight-cut or tucked-in</li> <li>• Official Drew Senior Academy necktie or cross-tie <b>REQUIRED</b> Monday - Thursday</li> <li>• Solid black polo** (Fridays only)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Pants and Skirts</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid khaki or official Drew plaid skirts worn <b>no more than three inches above the knee</b></li> <li>• Solid white, black, brown, gray or navy tights may be worn with a uniform skirt</li> </ul> <p><b>or -----</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid khaki pants or shorts worn no more than three inches above the knee (Cargo pants &amp; cargo shorts are not allowed)</li> <li>• Pants, shorts and skirts with belt-loops must be worn with a neutral-colored belt</li> </ul>
<p><b>Footwear</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any closed toe and school appropriate shoe. (No slides, flip flops, sandals, Crocs, Yeezy Foam Runners, Ugg slippers, or shoes with an open back.)</li> </ul>
<p><b>Jackets and Sweaters</b></p>	<p>Students are encouraged to wear their official Drew Senior Academy blazer on designated days and may be required to wear it for particular events. Students may also wear the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Outerwear purchased from Flynn O’Hara Uniforms, specifically: the V-Neck Sweater, Cardigan Sweater, V-Neck Pullover Sweater Vest and Polar Fleece Zip Front Jacket</li> <li>• Official Drew letterman jackets purchased from Creative Keystrokes (<a href="http://www.creativekeystrokes.net">www.creativekeystrokes.net</a>)</li> <li>• Official Drew athletic zip-up jackets purchased as part of participation in a sport</li> <li>• <b>SOLID</b> forest green, white, or black sweaters, sweatshirts, and hoodies**</li> </ul> <p>Official Drew outerwear is permitted <b>if shirt collar and tie are visible</b>. All other outerwear, including but not limited to jackets, vests, sweatshirts, hoodies and shooting shirts, are <b>NOT</b> permitted and should be removed upon entering the building.</p>

<p><b>Hair</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All hair and facial hair should be neatly groomed with respect to</li> <li>• cultural norms.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Accessories</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All accessories should be consistent with the formal and professional spirit of the uniform policy.</li> <li>• Head coverings are only allowed for religious reasons inside of the school building. (Bandanas, hoods, scarves, bonnets, hats, ski masks, etc. are not permitted). Senior Academy administration must be notified in advance.</li> <li>• Underwear, lingerie, bare cleavage, shoulders, midriffs, backs or hips should be covered at all times.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Other</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jeans Passes may be issued as a reward or incentive. Students with Jeans Passes are encouraged, but not required, to wear Drew spirit wear (t-shirt, jacket, sweatshirt, etc.) with their jeans. Students may wear jeans, cargo pants or other appropriate style pants without holes or rips above the knee. Students may also wear sneakers, but not flip-flops, slides or Crocs.</li> <li>• When approved by the administration, select team and spirit clothing may be allowed on particular school days. Organization/Club t-shirts cannot be worn in lieu of a shirt and tie unless explicit approval is given.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Uniform Schedule</b></p>	<p><b>Monday is Blazer Day</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All students are required to wear their blazer, button up shirt, and tie with khaki bottoms.</li> </ul> <p><b>Tuesday through Thursday are Regular Uniform Days</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All students are required to wear their button up shirt and tie with khaki bottoms.</li> </ul> <p><b>Friday is Polo Day</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students are permitted to wear their black polo or button up shirt and tie with khaki bottoms.</li> </ul>
