## **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The Art Teacher is responsible for planning, implementing, and evaluating engaging and developmentally appropriate art instruction for students in alignment with North Carolina and Richmond County Schools standards. The teacher fosters creativity, artistic skill, and cultural appreciation through a diverse curriculum, while supporting both curricular and extracurricular visual art activities. The Art Teacher maintains an inclusive, well-organized classroom environment that encourages student expression and growth, and contributes to the overall school program through collaboration and active participation.

- Create a classroom environment appropriate for grade level, incorporating the Principles of Design and Elements of Art
- Display student artwork in the classroom and throughout the school to showcase creativity and progress
- ➤ Introduce students to diverse artists and artworks from various cultures, time periods, and regions
- Maintain classroom materials, equipment, and school property with care and responsibility
- Communicate regularly and effectively with parents and guardians regarding student progress and participation
- Support school-wide policies, participate in staff meetings, and fulfill duties as assigned by administration
- Contribute to school initiatives by collaborating with staff in planning and evaluating school programs
- Share responsibility for the supervision of students during the school day, including transitions and duties
- ➤ Perform other duties and responsibilities as assigned by supervisor

## **WORKING ENVIRONMENT:**

The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require the following physical demands: some lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; and significant fine finger dexterity. Generally, the job requires sitting, walking, and standing. This job is performed in a generally clean and healthy environment. Work in this classification is considered light physical work requiring the exertion of up to 20 pounds of force occasionally and a negligible amount of force frequently or constantly to move objects.
