JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Drafting Teacher is responsible for delivering high-quality instruction in drafting and design to high school students. The teacher will plan, organize, and implement instructional programs aligned with North Carolina Essential Standards for Career ad Technical Education (CTE). The goal is to equip students with technical skills and knowledge in architectural and engineering drafting that support both academic and career readiness.

- ➤ Valid North Caolina Teaching License in Drafting (74070)
- Experience teaching or working in a drafting-related field (preferred)
- ➤ Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, and drafting software (e.g., AutoCAD)

- ➤ Teach Drafting I, Drafting II- Architectural, and Drafting II- Engineering course aligned with NC Essential Standards
- Plan and deliver engaging lessons that promote technical skill development and critical thinking

- Create a classroom environment conducive to learning and personal growth for all students
- Maintain classroom discipline and establish clear expectations for student behavior
- ➤ Instruct students in the safe and proper use of drafting tools, software, and equipment
- Evaluate student performance and provide timely feedback through progress reports and assessments
- Maintain accurate records of student attendance, grades, and instructional materials
- Communicate regularly with parents, counselors, and school staff regarding student progress
- ➤ Participate in school-wide supervision and extracurricular activities as assigned
- ➤ Attend professional development workshops and collaborate with colleagues in PLCs
- Recommend instructional materials and managing classroom inventory and equipment
- Adapt instruction to meet the diverse learning needs and styles of students

WORKING ENVIRONMENT:

The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require the following physical demands: some lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; and significant fine finger dexterity.
