

- ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:**

- Conduct basic masonry and concrete repairs on buildings and grounds
- Maintain school grounds by mowing, trimming, edging, and repairing outdoor areas
- Assist with herbicide application and maintain required usage records
- Deliver custodial supplies and equipment to school locations as needed
- Transport surplus materials, equipment, and furniture between sites
- Perform minor repairs on custodial and lawn equipment
- Inspect and clean roofs and gutters to ensure proper drainage and safety
- Coordinate grounds maintenance activities with other staff and departments
- Support other maintenance staff in completing work orders and projects
- Respond to after-hours maintenance emergencies as require
- Accept and complete additional assignments from supervisors as needed

WORKING ENVIRONMENT:

The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require the following physical demands: some lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; and significant fine finger dexterity. Work in this classification is considered light physical work requiring the exertion of up to 20 pounds of force occasionally and a negligible amount of force frequently or constantly to move objects. Generally, the job requires sitting, walking, and standing. This job is performed in a generally clean and healthy environment.
