JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Resource Teacher is responsible for providing curriculum support and instructional guidance to students, teachers, and administrators. This role focuses on enhancing instructional quality, supporting professional development, and aligning with educational practices with district goals. The Resource Teacher serves as a liaison between school staff and district curriculum teams, ensuring consistency and effectiveness in instructional delivery.

WORKING ENVIRONMENT:
