POSITION: STUDENT SUPPORT SPECIALIST

REPORTS TO: Assistant Superintendent of Safety and Support Services

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Student Support Specialist is responsible for developing, implementing, and monitoring a comprehensive Dropout Prevention Program and districtwide Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) initiatives. This role supports the academic, emotional, and social development of students by collaborating with school staff, families, and community partners. The specialist plays a key role in identifying at-risk students, coordinating interventions, and promoting a whole-child approach to education.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's degree in education, counseling, social work, or a related field (required)
- Five years of successful classroom or youth program experience (required)
- ➤ Familiarity with Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) and tools such as Major Clarity, Second Step, and DESSA

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- ➤ Develop and oversee a districtwide Dropout Prevention Program and SEL Initiatives
- Collaborate with middle and secondary school staff to identify at-risk students and create individualized support plans
- > Support implementation of Major Clarity for student career and academic planning
- ➤ Assist with the use of Second Step and DESSA tools to support Tier II and Tier III planning

- Prepare and analyze reports from the DESSA universal screener to guide student support strategies
- ➤ Provide professional development on trauma-informed practices, ACEs, and resilience
- Coordinate wraparound meetings with families, students, and school-based support teams
- Serve as a liaison between families and community resources to address barriers to learning
- > Support school counselors and teachers in implementing SEL programs and interventions
- Monitor and report on program effectiveness and student progress to the Director of Student Services
- Review school Indistar goals to align support with social-emotional action steps
- Maintain confidentiality, professionalism, and exemplary attendance
- ➤ Perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Student Services or school leadership

WORKING ENVIRONMENT:

The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require the following physical demands: some lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; and significant fine finger dexterity. Work in this classification is considered light physical work requiring the exertion of up to 20 pounds of force occasionally and a negligible amount of force frequently or constantly to move objects. Generally, the job requires sitting, walking, and standing. This job is performed in a generally clean and healthy environment.
