



## 2025-26 Dress Code & Uniform Policy

### Junior Academy

While attending school, all students must be in full uniform daily.\* Our uniform reflects our pride and our respect for our school. While specific guidelines are provided below, it is important for students to develop an understanding of and adherence to the spirit and standards of professional dress. Uniforms must be neat, and clean, and students should also practice good hygiene. If a student is out of uniform, parents/guardians will be contacted and required to bring the necessary items before students are admitted to class.

<b>Tops</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Solid white or heather grey</b> polo or oxford shirt</li> </ul>
<b>Bottoms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Solid khaki</b> pants, skirts, or shorts (worn no more than three inches above the knee)</li> <li>• Pants, shorts and skirts with belt-loops must be worn with a neutral colored belt</li> </ul>
<b>Footwear</b>	Any closed toe and school appropriate shoe. (No slides, flip flops, sandals, Crocs, slippers, or shoes with an open back.)
<b>Jackets</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Solid color jackets/hoodies only (black, forest green, white, tan, or heather grey).</b></li> <li>• Official Drew athletic pull over zip-up jackets purchased as part of participation in a sport.</li> <li>• Shirt collar should remain visible at all times. Jackets with hoods are <b>STRONGLY</b> discouraged. Students are not allowed to have hoods up inside the building at any time.</li> </ul>
<b>Hair</b>	All hair and facial hair should be neatly groomed with respect to cultural norms.
