Shirts

All clothing must conceal undergarments at all times.

Tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, muscle shirts, and any shirt that reveals cleavage, midriffs, backs, or chests are not allowed.

Head Coverings



Hats, hoodies, bandanas, sunglasses, masks*, sweatbands, arm and leg bands, and other outdoor or head apparel are prohibited.

An administrator may make exceptions for religious, medical, or safety reasons.

*Health masks are permitted.

Hoodies & Outerwear



Wearing outdoor jackets, coats, or hoodies is not permitted in <u>the</u> middle school.

Hooded articles of clothing are permitted at <u>the high school</u>, but only if the hoods are down and not worn on the head.

Dresses Pants & Shorts



Skirts, shorts, and dresses must be at mid-thigh or below.

Shorts, skirts, and pants must be appropriately sized for the student and worn at the waist.

Form-fitting garments, biking pants, or spandex are not allowed.

Clothing with large or inappropriately placed tears and holes is not allowed.

Flip-Flops & Slides



No slippers, no flip-flops.

For safety, Crocs and sandals should be worn with a heel strap.

Shoes must be worn at all times and must not pose a safety hazard.

Additional Violations



Sleepwear, including pajamas, bonnets, blankets, and slippers, is prohibited.

Clothing or accessories that could be interpreted as promoting hate, negative, profane, or vulgar messages are not permitted.
