**Fee payment.** As allowed by Kansas state statutes 72-5390 and 72-5389, fees will be collected at the beginning of each school year, or at the time of enrollment for students transferring into the district midyear. Online payments are available through the school district website and are subject to a convenience fee of \$3.00 per transaction. Once paid, fees are in effect throughout the school year and are not refundable. There will be a \$30 fee charged on all returned checks.

<b>Quest after-school program</b> Students in kindergarten through 5th grade.	\$1,300 per year or \$130 per month. Cap of \$2,100 per family.
<b>The ZONE after-school program</b> Students in grades 6-8.	\$100 per year or \$50 per semester. Cap of \$200 per family.
Driver education (summer)	\$225 per student, due at driver education enrollment in the spring. No fee waivers are available.

*Students who are enrolled by September 15, 2025 are charged the following fees:*

<b>Class Dues</b> <i>Each year, each student at EHS is assessed Class Dues</i>	9th Grade - \$15 10th Grade - \$25 11th Grade - \$25 12th Grade - \$35

**\*Students accepted after September 15, 2025 are assessed \$275 per course or .5 credit in addition to the above fees. Course fees must be paid before enrollment.**
