

GNPS EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROTOCOLS





SHELTER STUDENTS AND STAFF INSIDE THE BUILDING BECAUSE IT IS SAFER INSIDE THE **BUILDING THAN OUTSIDE**



HOLD **HOLD-IN-PLACE**

RESTRICT MOVEMENT OF STUDENTS AND STAFF WITHIN THE **BUILDING WHILE DEALING WITH** SHORT TERM **EMERGENCIES**



LOCKDOWN

SECURE STUDENTS AND STAFF INSIDE LOCKED CLASSROOMS DURING **INCIDENTS THAT POSE AN IMMEDIATE** THREAT OF VIOLENCE IN OR AROUND THE SCHOOL



SECURE LOCKOUT

STUDENTS AND STAFF **REMAIN INSIDE LOCKED SCHOOL BUILDINGS DURING INCIDENTS THAT**



EVACUATE STUDENTS AND STAFF FROM THE BUILDING

ACTIONS:

- Listen for instructions
- Students in hallways should return to assigned classroom, if possible
- Take attendance
- Staff assist students as needed
- Move away from windows if situation warrants
- If instructed, move out of classroom to designated safe area; take attendance upon arrival at the new location
- Stay together at all times
- Listen for updates

ACTIONS:

- Listen for instructions
- Students in hallways should return to assigned classroom, if possible
- Take attendance
- Staff assist students as needed
- Listen for updates

ACTIONS:

- If safe, gather students from hallways, common areas
- **LOCK YOUR DOOR**, barricade if necessary
- Move students to a safe area in the classroom out of sight of the door
- Leave windows, blinds / lights as they are
- Keep everyone quiet. Silence cell phones
- **DO NOT** communicate through the door or answer the room phone
- ONLY respond to PA Announcements. or Fire Alarm if there is an immediate life safety hazard based on observed conditions • ALL OUTDOOR (smoke, fire, heat)
- If you are outside, **DO NOT** return to the building. Leave school grounds until you are in a safe location

ACTIONS:

OF THE SCHOOL

POSE AN IMMINENT **CONCERN OUTSIDE**

- Lock all exterior doors and windows
- Leave blinds / lights as they are (unless directed)
- Take attendance
- After initial instructions, listen for updates
- Classroom instruction continues as normal
- activities shall cease immediately and moved indoors
- Listen for updates

ACTIONS:

- Listen for instructions
- Lead students to designated assembly area. Use secondary route, if necessary
- Students in hallways should evacuate through the nearest exit
- Bring attendance list and class roster
- Close the classroom door after exiting
- Take attendance when safe to do so
- If evacuating off site, take attendance before moving
