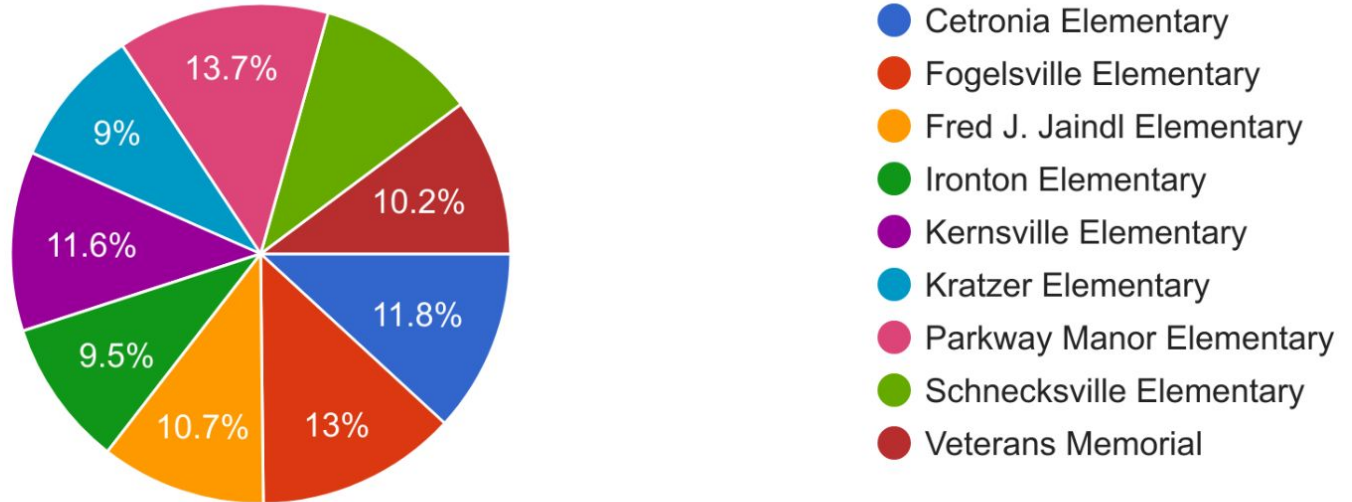

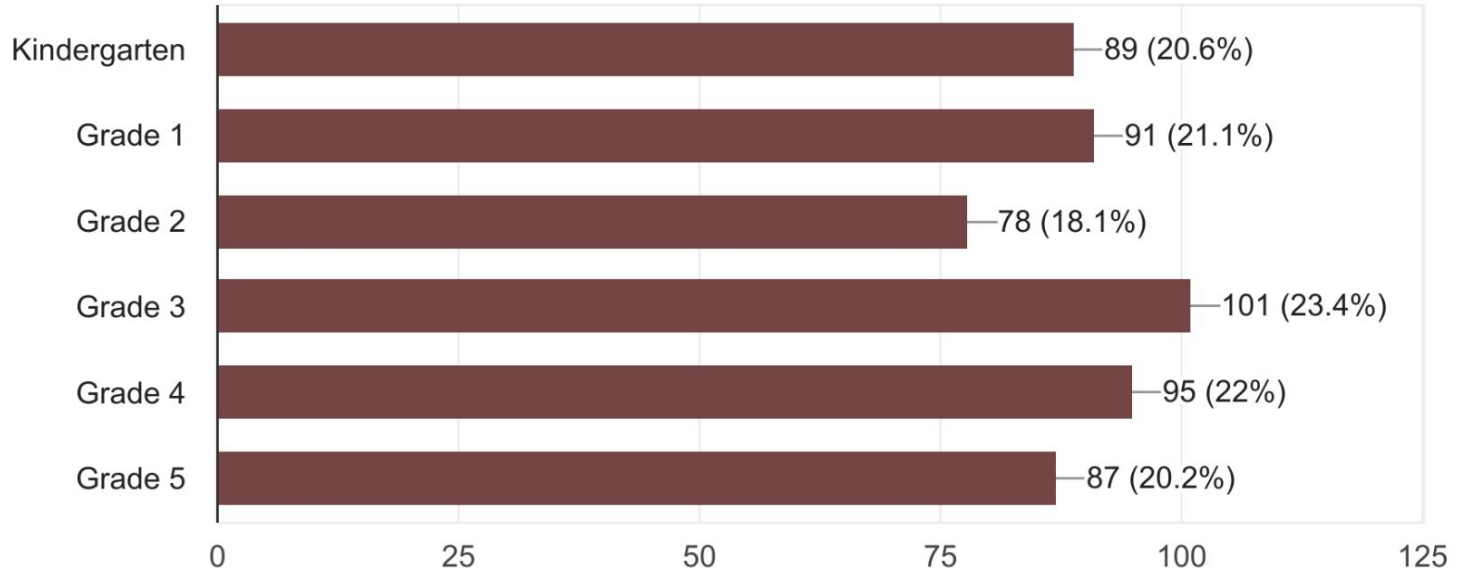

In what grade is your child(ren) enrolled? (Check all that apply.)

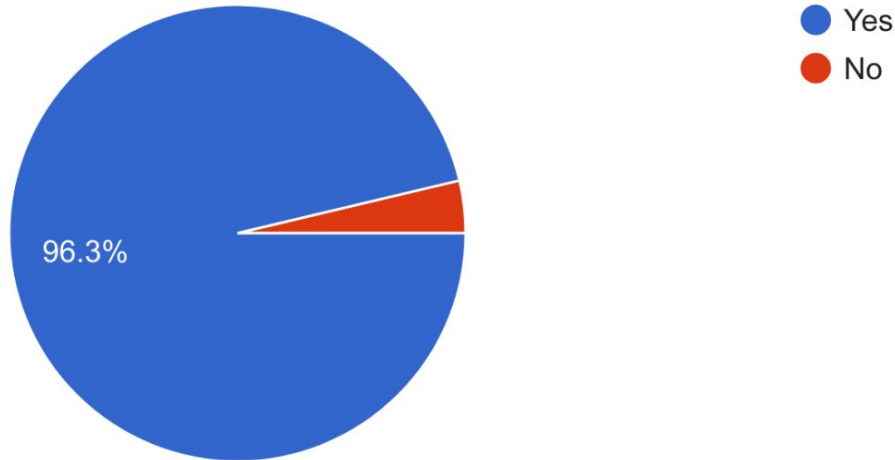

Does your child have a positive attitude toward school?

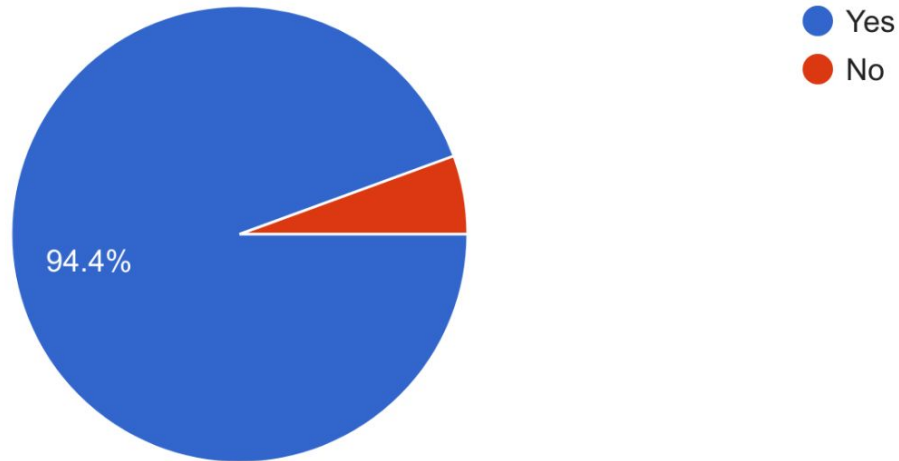

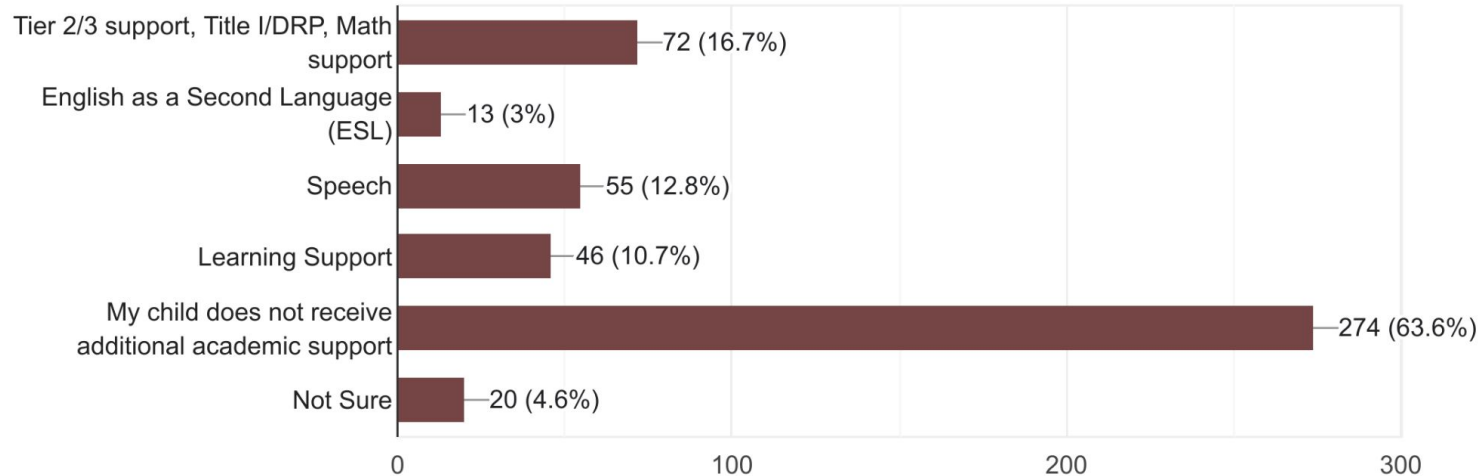

- My son just started in parkland I'm used to ClassDojo app with regular communication with the teachers it's unusual for me not to have the open communication we had in BASD
- Sees reading specialist during swim
- My 3rd grader is in tier 3 for reading and it's been very helpful!
- I feel like my daughter isn't where she should be as a usual 4th grader.
- His intervention teacher has really encouraged him and he has made progress thanks to this relationship.
- All of my 4 children have been in Tier 2 at some point or another. 2 of them make improvements and not longer needed support while the other 2 continued to struggle. I think it is a great program to try to catch kids up that are able too but for those kids with true learning differences I feel it prolongs diagnosis and proper help. Both of my children who did not make progress in Tier 2/3 were not offered IEP testing, my husband and I requested it. If we saw the Tier process out it would have been a lot longer until proper diagnosis was obtained. I understand the tier process's intentions however if children are not making progress I think offering testing sooner rather than later would be beneficial. Especially for those children whose parents may not be so involved.
- "My daughter has received lower forms of title support for reading in Grades 1 &2. She was phased out when she reached the appropriate level but was places in a more aggressive program in the 3rd grade. It wasn't until this time, and when we pressed, that we were put in touch (at our request) the with reading specialists and provided details on her assessments. Those had never been provided in prior years and we didn't even know they were being done. Further, having the details of WHERE/WHAT she was struggling with specifically gave us more direction on how we could support at home. I'm still unclear as to why we had to ask for this information vs. it being shared and explained directly on a regular cadence. We are fortunate enough to be able to afford a tutor who is wonderful and is helping my daughter improve in the areas of need, but again, had we not taken the initiative, my concern would be that she would have been passed through the system/program and again put in a position in the following grade where she might again struggle."

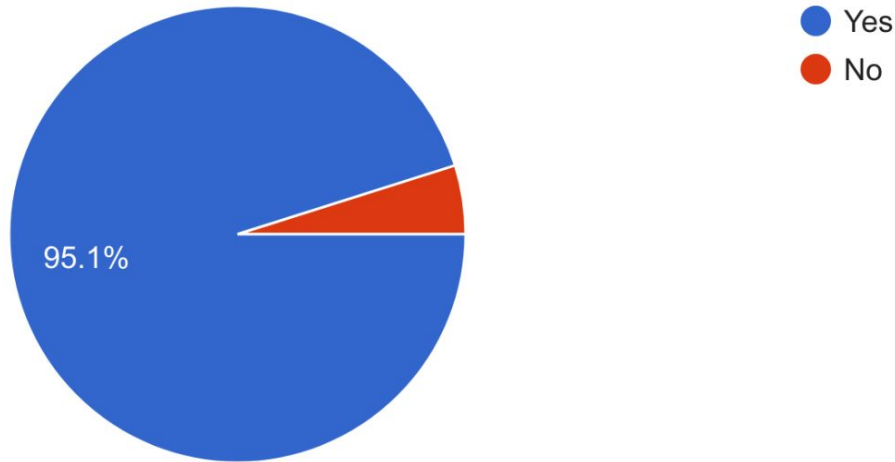

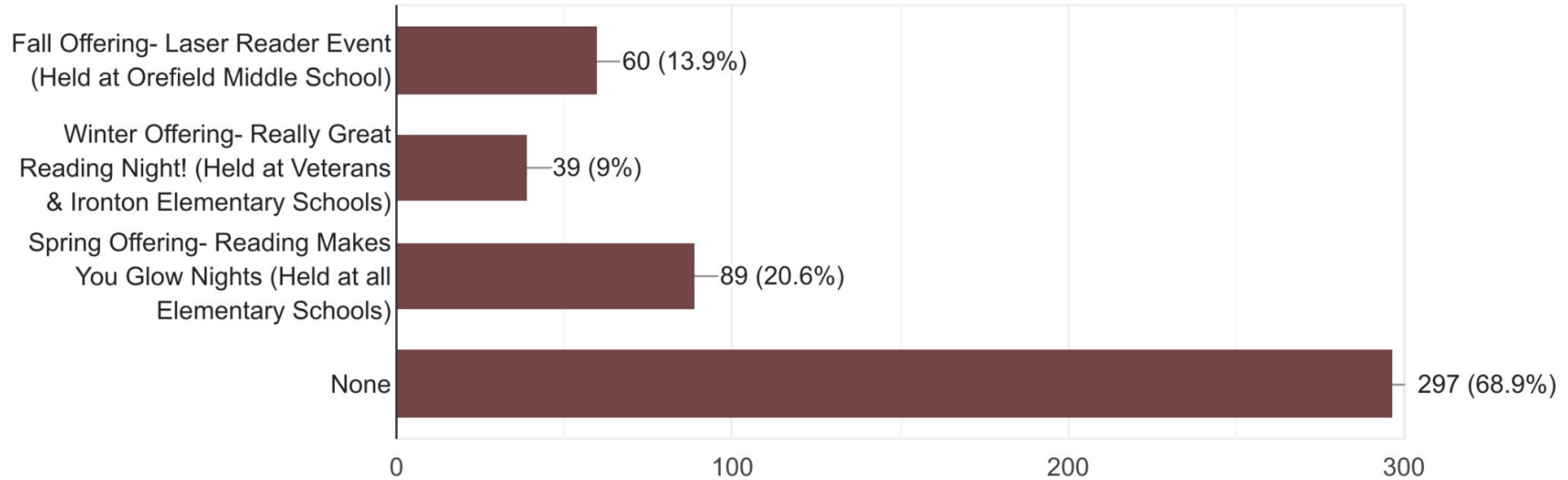

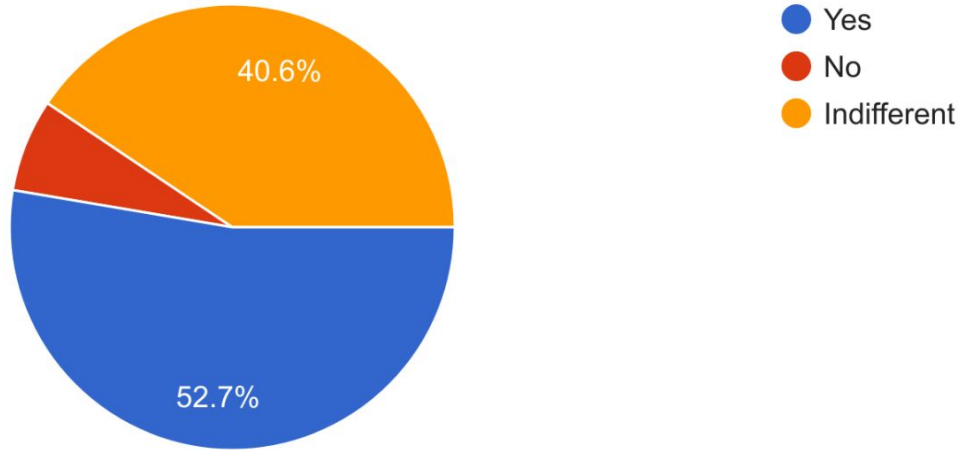
- The Reading Makes You Glow Night was definitely geared toward the younger kids and the activities (besides Bingo) were not very engaging for 4th and 5th graders.
