<u>General Dance Rules</u>	<u>Dance Conduct and Behavior</u>
<p>All school dances are for Beckman High School Students. All Beckman students must comply with the school/district rules as well as the listed additional rules. Any dance guest (non-Beckman student) accompanying a Beckman student must also comply with the following guidelines as well as submit a 'Guest Permission Slip'. All attendees must present current school identification to be admitted. Prom is a formal dance. Students may not enter any dance 60 minutes after start time. All school rules and regulations apply to all in attendance. Students may leave a dance at any time. Parents may be called if they leave in the first 90 minutes. BHS supervision is not responsible for them after they leave the dance. The following items are not permitted into the dance and will be confiscated: gum, perfume, lotion, mints, food, or beverages. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Students who leave the dance for any reason will not be readmitted.</p> <p><i>NOTE: Students with outstanding detentions to serve must clear their detentions prior to the purchase of the ticket.</i></p>	<p>This is a high school dance. All those in attendance must abide by the following guidelines while dancing; No Freaking, No bending over, No riding legs, No inappropriate/sexually suggestive dancing as determined by the BHS Administration. The BHS wristband policy will be in effect. Students receive one warning for inappropriate dancing; for a second offense they are removed from the dance and a parent is called. Possession and/or use of tobacco, alcohol and controlled substances are prohibited. Any student (or guest) arriving at the event under the influence of (or in possession of) an illegal substance will not be admitted. In addition to alerting local law enforcement, and receiving appropriate school discipline, you will be called to <u>pick up your child from the dance</u>. If you cannot be reached, the incident will be referred to the local police department.</p> <p>BHS reserves the right to conduct a breathalyzer test; the test will be conducted by a school administrator and/or school resource officer.</p>

<u>Dress Code</u>	<u>Guest Permission Slip</u>
<p><u>General Dress Code Information:</u> Many of our dances are themed and dressing within this theme is encouraged. All school dress policies still apply, however, and will be enforced. Information regarding themes and dress attire suggestions will be advertised weeks prior to any school dance thru campus publicity, social media publicity and on our school website.</p> <p><u>Prom is a formal event:</u> Options for attire include: Dress slacks/pants, Dress Shirt with collar and tie, skirt and blouse, pantsuits, or dresses (mid-thigh to floor length). Coats and dress shoes are highly recommended.</p> <p>Students dressed inappropriately (against school dress code) will not be admitted and will be asked to go home and change. Please check prior to the dance if you have any concerns about appropriate dance attire.</p>	<p>Guests must be under the age of 21 and at least in ninth grade. To purchase a ticket for a non-BHS student, you will need a completed permission slip and a copy of your guest's ID (for each dance - no yearly permission slips for non-BHS student will be accepted). Guest passes are available at the student store and only one guest per BHS student will be admitted. If the guest is out of high school, they must meet with a BHS administrator for approval. For more information, please contact a school administrator.</p> <p>BHS students bringing a non-BHS student MUST purchase a BHS Plus GUEST ticket with both forms at the same time. Any tickets not purchased at the same time will result in the BHS ticket being charged the difference in price from purchase date to repurchase date. This is different from a BHS student only ticket.</p> <p>BHS student with NON-BHS guest tickets are not available on line and MUST be purchased in person at the students</p>
