### **Spectators**

To help us provide the safest and best fan experience possible, please make note of the following reminders and protocols for attending West Park Athletic contests:

- Fans who live in the West Park neighborhood, whenever possible, please consider walking, riding, or carpooling to games. West Park HS is a very busy campus and parking is limited

  - Please purchase tickets prior to arriving on campus to help speed up entry
  - Please note that there is a \$1 service fee charged by the GoFan corporation

- We have a snack bar at many of our contests and they typically take both cash and card

### PLEASE MAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS/GUIDELINES

- ★ All children through grade 8 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.
  - o An adult can accompany up to 2 children
- ★ All students attending need to show their school ID in order to enter
- ★ There are no backpacks allowed in the Stadium and Arena

- ★ There are no footballs/basketballs or other sports equipment allowed in the Stadium or Arena
- ★ Spectators should keep all walkways clear and watch the game from the stands
- ★ Spectator access to the field/court is limited to pre-arranged special occasions
  - At the conclusion of Stadium games, families can meet their athletes on the turf in front of the ticket booth
  - At the conclusion of Arena games, families can meet their athletes in the Arena foyer or outside the lobby

### **Additional Visitor Information:**

### **Families:**

We welcome all West Park parents, guardians, and family members with paid admission.

### **Visitors over 18:**

Anyone age 18 and over may attend the game with paid admission.

## Non-High School Aged Children

We enjoy catering to all spectators with paid admission, but due to the lack of supervision and liability reasons, any persons under the age of 18 years old who are not current West Park students may not attend without an adult chaperone (this includes our resident middle school students).

• Children are required to sit with their adult chaperone for their safety and to avoid unacceptable behaviors.

# High School Students (non-West Park Students)

We welcome our local high school students with paid admission to attend our home football games.

- Must show school ID upon entry.
- Students within the RJUHSD school district must adhere to district policy. Students are subject to school and possible legal consequences for any EdCode and/or Penal Codes that may be violated (e.g. controlled substance, fighting, weapons).

### **Current West Park Students**

We welcome all current West Park students to attend all of our home games with paid admission and encourage them to cheer with their peers in The Claw Student Section.

### Students must:

- Limit their bags to a clutch-sized hand-bag. Students who bring bags larger in size will be required to leave it outside of the stadium for the duration of their stay. (West Park HS is not responsible for lost or stolen items.)
- Must adhere to our current Dress Code Policy.
- Must adhere to the same rules as <u>The Claw Student Section</u> even if not sitting in this section.
- May not be on the <u>No-Go List</u>
- This is a school-event. All school and district policies apply. Students are subject to school and possible legal consequences for any EdCode and/or Penal Codes that may be violated (e.g. controlled substance, fighting, weapons).
