Mission Statement: We value people and we love to learn.

We value people and understand that students have personal needs. They are invited to use the restroom anytime they need. To provide safety and security, the following list the few rules to help mitigate any potential issues that could occur during restroom use:

- Only <u>one</u> student may leave class at a time to use the restroom.
- Students must use the restroom in the building where your current classroom is located (e.g. students who have a class in the Oak must use the restroom located in the Oak building).
- Only <u>one</u> student at a time in each stall.
- Recording or photography of any kind is <u>never</u> permitted to allow privacy for all.
- Students must limit their time in the restroom to the minimum amount needed (average time usage is approximately 2-3 minutes).
- Students who would like a private use restroom are welcome to go to the Administration Offices.
- Students who miss class to use the restroom are still responsible for any work or instruction they may have missed and should ask the teacher for help, if necessary.
