Put these statements in order of the time they happened.

- Ruby took the school-entrance test at five years old and passed it.
- A group of Black parents challenged the unfairness of segregated schools and eventually their cases were heard by the U.S. Supreme Court.
- Some states did not follow the Supreme Court ruling and still kept schools segregated.
- Ruby Bridges was born in the state of Mississippi
- The U.S. Supreme Court ruled that schools need to allow all kids to attend and learn together, making segregation in schools illegal. (Brown vs. Board of Education case)
- Members of the New Orleans school board in Louisiana created a test only for Black kindergarteners to make it more difficult for Black children to attend an all-white school as first graders.
- When Ruby was four, she and her family moved from Mississippi to Louisiana.
