The Legend faculty and staff are well educated and qualified. There are 180 staff members that work with Legend students and of those 119 are certified teachers. Ten administrations provide students with academic support services.

PROGRAMS

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

Legend High School offers 26 Advanced Placement courses. Students in AP classes participate in a rigorous curriculum preparing them for AP exams and potential college credit.

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

A student who successfully enrolls in a concurrent enrollment course will have the opportunity to earn both high school and college credit. Legend High School currently has 47 concurrent enrollment classes for the 2025 - 2026 school year.

ADVANCEMENT VIA INDIVIDUAL DETERMINATION (AVID)

AVID is an academic program that focuses on writing as a tool of learning, the inquiry method, collaborative teamwork, organization and reading. AVID students are enrolled in a rigorous college preparatory curriculum as well as an elective AVID class that provides academic instruction, tutorial support and motivational activities.

EDGE (Explore, Discover, Grow, Empower)

EDGE is an alternative path for students interested in personalized learning, project based learning, and memorable learning experiences. EDGE is a four year program which allows for mentors to facilitate a gradual release of learning experience.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Legend provides a full complement of both boys' and girls' interscholastic sports and many special interest clubs and organizations. The pursuit of involvement and of success remains a constant theme in all of the school's activity programs.
