

- Standard sized Backpack (large enough to carry a folder without it being bent)
- Complete change of clothes (including underwear and socks) in a large zip lock bag to be kept in school bags
- Snack bag (a small bag to keep snack organized and separate from other items in backpack
- A simple snack to be brought daily (it should include items from 2 different food groups)
- A reusable water bottle to be brought daily
- Toileting items as needed (diapers, pull-ups, wipes; no medication or creams)
- 1 box of tissues*
- 1 containers of unscented baby wipes*
- 2 rolls of paper towels*
- 1 box of ziploc bags* (The teacher will specify the needed size at Open House snack, sandwich, or quart)
- 2 containers of antibacterial/disinfectant wipes

- *2 Boxes of 24 count <u>CRAYOLA</u> Crayons-NO JUMBO PLEASE
- *8 Glue Sticks
- 1 Pair of FISKARS Scissors please write first name on handle with Sharpie
- 1 Pencil Pouch 3 ring and **MUST** have zipper closure (7x9" size)
- *2 Box of Tissues- Minimum 120 count per box
- 1 Container of Antibacterial/ Disinfectant Wipes
- 4 black <u>EXPO</u> dry erase markers fine tip
- 1 bottle of <u>Elmer's</u> school glue
- 4 (3 or 4 oz) containers of <u>PlayDoh</u>
- Extra set of clothes with underwear (labeled in a clear gallon bag with your child's name) to keep at school for occasional accidents/spills
