## Attendance Zone Changes

### F.A.Q.

#### **Can my 11th or 12th grade student remain at their current school?**

Yes. The link to submit a stay request is located on the Child Welfare and Attendance district page.

#### **Does my student have to attend to the new school?**

Yes, all students are required to attend their zoned school. However, interested parents and/or guardians can apply for a transfer request per district transfer eligibility requirements. Transfer request forms are located on the Child Welfare and Attendance district page.

#### **Can my student continue with athletics?**

Yes. All students impacted by the new attendance zone line changes will be LHSA-eligible.

#### **Will transportation be provided to the new school?**

Yes, in accordance with board policy, all students will continue to receive transportation services.

#### **My child has an IEP or 504 Plan. Will they continue to receive accommodations at the new school?**

Yes. All students will continue to receive services according to their IEP or 504 Plan.

#### **Why is this happening?**

As part of decades-old litigation, the United States District Court for the Western District of Louisiana ordered changes to several current attendance zone lines for the St. Martin Parish School System.
