Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Spring-Ford Area School District has developed plans to respond to incidents at the Limerick Generating Station. If the school district receives notice of an alert prior to 6 a.m., school will be closed. There are also plans to address incidents which may occur during the school day. Your cooperation is essential to the success of each plan.

IN THE EVENT OF AN ALERT

- Students will remain within their school building.
- The superintendent will notify transportation providers and place vehicles on standby for early dismissal.
- Special activities will be canceled, schools will prepare for early dismissal.

IN THE EVENT OF A SITE AREA EMERGENCY

- The superintendent will initiate routine early dismissal procedure.
- Students will be dismissed according to their routine method of transportation. For example, if a student is typically a picked up at school, a parent/guardian should plan on picking the student up. If a student rides a bus home, the student will ride their bus home.
- DO NOT RUSH. DRIVE SAFELY.

IN THE EVENT OF A GENERAL EMERGENCY

- Students will be transported to a "host" school. The host school is Montgomery County Community College, Central Campus, 340 DeKalb Pk., Blue Bell, PA.
- Parents/guardians may pick up their child(ren) at the "host" school before 8 p.m.
- DO NOT RUSH. DRIVE SAFELY. The host school is located near an official evacuation route.
- DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PICK UP YOUR CHILDREN AT THEIR SCHOOL! It is important that school driveways and access routes remain open for busses. While preparing to evacuate it is difficult to release students and keep an accurate school census.
- Students will always remain under the supervision of the school staff.
- Students at the "host" school will only be released to parents, legal guardians or individuals having prior approval.
