Special Comments And
Interpretations

*Any attire, dress code item, hairstyle, or grooming choice that, in the judgment of a school leader, interferes with, distracts from, or disrupts the school environment is prohibited.
*The dress code applies to all extra curricular events, assemblies, and activities at school and/or school sponsored events off-campus.
*The Principal can make adjustments to the dress code as needed.

Shirts Blouses

- Polo style in Red, White, Gray, or Black
- Shirts must be worn at a reasonable length.
- Name monogramming and school logo must be in Red, White, Black and Silver. (School logo is optional)
- Spirit shirts may be worn.**
- Spirit shirts must be red, white, gray, or black with *acceptable* designs and school logos.
- Special Occasion T-shirts must be approved by administrators.
- Homemade Spirit shirts must be approved by the Campus Leaders. (Must be Red, White, Gray, or Black)
- College shirts may be worn on Wednesdays.

- No** display of undergarments.
- No** oversized shirts.
- No** midriff/crop tops

Sweaters,
Jackets
& Coats

- All jackets/sweaters must have **full** zippers or buttons and may be in any color.
- Pull over sweaters must be in red, white, gray, or black.

*No offensive or distracting logos or messages on sweaters and/or jackets.

- Athletic hoodies can be worn during athletics, or during the athletic events; just not during the school day.
- **No** trench coats allowed.
- **No** military type of camouflage.
- ****Sweaters, jackets, or coats sold by school organizations must be approved by campus or district administration.**
- **Hoodies will be allowed;** they must not be worn in the building or in the classroom.

<p style="text-align: center;">Pants/Slacks</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pants should fit properly at the waist and crotch ● Uniform style khaki pants and jeans can have no more than five pockets. ● Minor frayed jeans allowed (no skin showing). <p style="text-align: center;"><u>ELEMENTARY ONLY</u></p> <p><i>EE through Pre-K ONLY:</i> Knee Length Knit shorts with elastic will be allowed (black or denim only)</p> <p><i>EE-Pre-K through 5th Grade ONLY:</i> Elastic waist bottoms/with or without buttons will be allowed (black or denim only)</p> <p><i>EE-Pre-K through 5th Grade ONLY:</i> Blue jean shorts, uniform style khaki shorts, skorts, dress jumpers & capris. <i>*shorts must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No baggy pants/jeans ● No wind pants, side snaps or sweats will be allowed ● No leggings and/or tights ● No overalls ● No blue jean skirts ● No Dresses grades 6-12 ● No jogger style pants allowed. ● No Pajamas <p>** Jeans must be blue/black in color. Slack/pants may be worn in black/khaki only. No other color will be allowed.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Shoes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Shoes must be worn at all times. ● Sandals must have a backstrap. ● Shoes with laces must be tied. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No Crocs ● No shower flip flops, house shoes, stilettos, steel toed boots/shoes, sports cleats, and shoes with wheels are prohibited.
<p style="text-align: center;">Hair</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Hair must be clean and neatly groomed and kept out of the eyes. ● Boys' hair length must not touch the top of the polo shirt/dress shirt collar and fall below the middle of the ear or below the eyebrow. ● Boys must be clean shaven daily. <p>**No Man Buns</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No mohawks. ● No indentations or designs on hair or eyebrows are allowed. ● No unnatural hair coloring --- natural highlights are acceptable. Hair may not be dyed, streaked, or highlighted in any unnatural hair color(s) i.e. red, blue, green, pink, purple, etc. This includes, but is not limited to: braids, ponytails, weaves, wigs, beads, hair extensions, etc.

<p>Jewelry Tattoos</p>	<p>•Earrings may be worn on the lobe of the ear (girls only). Males must remove all earrings and may not be covered.</p> <p>**Earrings/piercings deemed a distraction or dangerous will be confiscated.</p>	<p>•No decorative chains or chains on wallets. •No visible body piercings other than the lobe of the ear and no mouth jewelry. •No gauges. •No visible tattoos. (Must be covered at all times)</p>
<p>General</p>	<p><i>School approved uniforms for physical education, athletics, pep rallies, etc., may be worn only during class or activity for which they are approved.</i></p> <p>*EE/Pre-K through 2nd grade backpack: Does Not have to be clear or mesh; appropriate cartoon characters and/or print are acceptable.</p> <p>3rd-12th backpack: Must be clear or mesh only</p>	<p>•No attire, belt buckles, hats, caps or other accessories with advertisement of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons, drug paraphernalia, and/or derogatory nature on campus or school related activity. •No extreme or distracting makeup. •No face/body decorating with make-up, pens, markings or face paint. •No caps, hair nets, sweatbands, bandanas, sunglasses, or other head coverings may be worn indoors.</p>
<p>Special Events/College Course Requirements</p>	<p>For unique or special events the campus administration will establish event specific dress code requirements and communicate with parents and students with sufficient notice.</p> <p>College Course Uniforms/PPE must be followed. (See Syllabus)</p>	<p>Awards Assemblies/Induction Ceremonies: Business formal attire required.</p> <p>Banquets: Business casual attire required.</p> <p>Prom: Appropriate formal attire for boys and girls.</p>
<p>Gang Related Attire</p>	<p>•Items of this nature are strictly prohibited. This includes but, is not limited to: documented insignias, symbols, color combinations of clothing, hair styles/cuts, etc.</p>	<p>•No oversized necklaces, dog chains, etc. •No short pants worn with knee-high socks. •No pants worn low, or “sagging” and cuffed inside on the bottom are prohibited.</p>
