

Sixth Grade Supply List 2025 - 2026

Teachers will generally inform students on the first day of school what will be needed for their classes. However, to help prepare over the summer the 6th Grade Team suggests gathering:

General supplies

- **Pencils** (*steady supply replenished throughout the year*)
- **Wired headphones - a spare pair to leave in school (inexpensive)**
- Pens (blue or black)
- 2 highlighters
- 2 Sharpies
- 1 set of colored pencils
- Cap erasers
- Zippered pencil case
- Hand-held pencil sharpener

<u>Literacy</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● One 1½ -inch binder● Set of 5 binder dividers● 3-hole lined paper● 1 pack of index cards● 2 marble composition notebooks (any color)● 4 packs of 3x3 Post-its, different colors● 2 double-pocket folders	<u>Social Studies</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1-inch binder OR a pocket folder (for handouts)● 1 marble composition notebook with name on the front in Sharpie● A wired headset is needed all year to access audio files
<u>Math</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1-inch binder● Notebook - spiral bound or composition	<u>Science</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1-inch binder● Set of 3 dividers
<u>Math I/E</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1-inch binder or folder● Composition notebook	<u>Art</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Sketchbook 8 ½ by 11
<u>French:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 100 Colored Flashcards (Blue, Pink, Yellow)● 1-inch binder with loose-leaf paper● Set of 3 dividers	<u>Spanish:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1-inch binder with loose-leaf paper● 1 composition notebook

Locker shelves are not required. If you plan to buy locker shelves, the 6th-grade student lockers are 11 X 11, so standard locker shelving will fit.
