

- **This proposed Capital Projects Levy is not a new tax**, and will replace a previous voter-approved levy which will be expiring soon. This replacement levy ensures a stable tax rate for our community.
- Levy recommendations are community-informed. Projects proposed in the Capital Projects Levy are based on recommendations from the Facilities Advisory Committee. Committee members include community, staff, and parents who have studied facility conditions, consulted with facilities experts, and identified proposed solutions.
- The recommendation of the Facilities Advisory Committee have been made with future capital proposals in mind. Efficient use of taxpayer dollars is a high priority for the committee and the district. District maintenance projects will extend the life of our facilities and prioritize safety & security.
