TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A DRIVING PERMIT, YOU MUST:

1. Be in possession of a Class "D" license. (Due to limited spaces, only seniors may apply for parking permits at Barry Tech).
2. Have an afterschool job or an administrator approved extenuating circumstance.
3. Have permission from your parent or guardian and home school district to drive to school.
4. Maintain a strong attendance record.
5. Maintain an average grade of 70 or better in your BOCES course of study.
6. A Parking Permit Request filled out and signed by all parties accompanied by a copy of a valid Class D License, vehicle registration and insurance card.

RULES GOVERNING PERSONAL VEHICLE USE:

1. You may not drive to Nassau BOCES until you have the physical driving pass in your possession.
2. A Parking Permit must always be visibly displayed on campus.
3. Students must park in the designated student parking area only, and only leave when dismissed.
4. Students must always follow directions from staff members on campus and in the parking lot.
5. No passengers are permitted to accompany students to or from Nassau BOCES.
6. Hazardous driving may result in loss of privileges.
7. Suspension from your home district or a BOCES program may result in immediate revocation of the driving pass.
8. Off campus parking is not permitted under any circumstance.

The parking permit may be suspended or revoked at any time.

Parent-Teen Driving Contract

- Parking Permits will be assigned through a lottery system for students who meet the criteria and submit a Parking Permit Request form.
- Students issued parking permits must comply with the listed rules below.
- Non-compliance may result in a verbal warning, phone call home, disciplinary action, or/and immediate removal of parking privilege.
- Parental acknowledgment of these rules is necessary for students to receive a permit.
- Parent/ guardian and student must initial below to indicate agreement and understanding with the following requirements:
 1. You may not drive to Nassau BOCES until you have the physical driving pass in your possession.
 2. A Parking Permit must always be visibly displayed on campus.

Speeding and Driver Error

Speed-related crashes accounted for 34% of fatalities among 16-19 years olds. Speeding is a factor in 1 of every 3 teen fatal crashes.

Cellphones & Texting

NY State law prohibits all drivers from using portable electronic devices. Illegal activity includes holding a portable electronic device and talking on a handheld mobile phone, composing, sending, reading, accessing, browsing, transmitting, saving, or retrieving electronic data such as e-mail, text messages or webpages; viewing, taking, or transmitting images; and or playing games. Of fatal crashes among 15-19 year old drivers involving distractions, 21% were identified as using cellphones.
