Concrete slab removal work is nearly complete in the Basement, and underground plumbing is closely behind. An upcoming concrete pourback will get this floor re-established for the final upgrades to the mechanical system to go in place!

Roof work is complete on all main roofs on the building with only a few small copper roofs to replace yet. The full scope of roofing upgrades will be complete shortly into summer. We are looking forward to a great summer of work ahead and are eager to share it with you along the way!
