

## ***Oakmont High School IB Access Policy***

Oakmont High School prides itself on having an inclusive, accessible IB Program. We strive to offer IB courses that meet the needs of all learners. For some students, this may mean enrolling in the full IB Diploma Program, and for others it may mean taking one or more IB courses as part of their high school experience.

According to the IB Mission Statement, “the International Baccalaureate aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.”

Students who enroll in IB courses at OHS should be inspired by that mission statement. In addition, students who would like to enroll in IB classes should follow the recommended course pathways listed for each course on the [IB Course Planning Guide](#) on the [OHS IB Website](#). Students and their parents are also required to read the [OHS IB Handbook](#) and sign the [OHS IB Honor Code](#). These will be sent out to each student and their family the Fall of the year they have enrolled in an IB class. If students and parents do not sign and turn in the OHS IB Honor Code, the student may not be enrolled in any IB course.

The OHS Access Policy will be annually reviewed by the IB team each year, and it will be posted under the OHS Policies on the IB Program website for Oakmont High School
