Free from rash, itching, and fever for 24 hours, or A note from the provider to return	Return to school after 24 hours on an antibiotic with a provider note	Released by the medical provider to return to school, and discharge papers for the school nurse	Treat with appropriate lice treatment at home. If needed call your provider for treatment
