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Junior High

Study Skills

- One 3-prong plastic folder with pockets
- One 25-26 academic year student planner or one sticky note wallet/notebook and a year's supply of sticky notes (either works, choose the best option and size for your child and family)
- One 1" binder (not a trapper keeper)
- **Optional but might be beneficial**
- Locker shelf organizer (hanging ones or single shelves that don't rest on the locker floor)
- Magnetic marker holder
- Refrigerator magnet clips

Science

- One 3-prong plastic folder with pockets
- Notebook/paper (at least 100 pages just for science)
- Pre-sharpened or mechanical pencils
- One big pink eraser
- Two different color highlighters
