Approved Asset Control Solutions to provide the Fixed Asset Re-Inventory Evaluation for a total price of \$27,000.

Approved a contract with MG Tactical Advantage, LLC for a District Risk & Vulnerability Assessment including the evaluation/review of all critical incident management and hazard plans for a total cost of \$66,700.00.

Approved a Development Agreement with Doylestown Township, provide a Letter of Credit in the amount \$306,481.73, and payment in the amount of \$20,000 made payable to the Township for legal, engineering and inspection fees necessary for the CB West High School – Athletic Field Complex Renovation project.
