"Tonight, we welcome new officers of the Bridge Valley Elementary Executive Board, while saying a massive thank you to those that are passing the torch.


As you step into these leadership roles, you carry with you the trust of this community and the shared commitment to serve our students, families, and staff with integrity, creativity, and care.
