SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Final 2012-2013 Budget Presentation. Mr. Matyas provided a powerpoint on the 2012-2013 budget. On December 5 the initial budget was \$288,338,142 and estimated revenues were \$286,338,142. The district continues to experience declining local, state, and federal revenues of approximately \$15M. Local real estate assessment appeals will probably continue in 2012-2013. The district has 22% of Bucks County students and 46% of the real estate assessment appeals.

As of May 22 a total of 14 staffing reductions (2 administrators, 11 professional staff, and 1 support staff) have been made for the 2012-2013 school year. These cuts will save the district \$820,000 per year. Staffing reductions from 2008 through 2013 (a total of 237.5 positions) save the district \$6.1M per year.

The district will continue to explore ways to enhance revenues and reduce costs. The recommended millage increase for this budget is 1.66%. This is the second lowest tax increase since the early 90's. The typical homeowner will pay an additional \$80.

The Board is being asked to adopt the final budget of \$287,238,850 on June 12. Administration will begin to implement staffing reductions, continue to reduce transportation costs, and find a way to retain the extended-day kindergarten program. Board members are asked to continue support for district initiated assessment appeals, and work with legislators to secure more state funding and the elimination of mandates.

Approval of Memorandum of Agreement between Central Bucks School District and the Central Bucks Transportation Association.

Mr. Fred D’Angelo, labor attorney, provided details of the Transportation Memorandum of Agreement. The district and the transportation union have been negotiating for the past 15 months on a new contract and will continue to work on a new labor contract. In the interim, this Memorandum of Agreement will provide an incentive of \$5,000 to assist with a “health care transition” for 44 members who volunteer to resign or retire effective June 30, 2012. The election to participate must be made by May 30, 2012. This will result in a savings of \$15,000 in year one and an overall cumulative savings of approximately \$7.5M by school year 2021-2022. Mr. D’Angelo stated that union members ratified the Memorandum of Agreement prior to Board consideration.

Mr. Faulkner asked if anyone wished to make a public comment before the Board acted on this agenda item. There was no public comment made.

In response to an earlier comment made during Public Comment (Action Items) Mr. Faulkner asked Mr. Garton why the Memorandum of Agreement was not posted along with other May 22, 2012 agenda documents on the cbsd website. Mr. Garton responded that this agreement was covered by the Sunshine Act as a confidential matter and sometimes during negotiations contracts evolve up until the last minute – therefore the Memorandum of Agreement was not posted.

Upon a motion by Mr. Corr, seconded by Mr. Tomlinson, with all members present voting aye, the Memorandum of Agreement between Central Bucks School District and the Central Bucks Transportation Association was approved. (Attachment A).



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
between
CENTRAL BUCKS SCHOOL DISTRICT
and
CENTRAL BUCKS TRANSPORTATION ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Central Bucks School District (hereinafter "District") currently transports a portion of its student population in buses that are driven by District employees;

WHEREAS, the District employees who drive said buses are represented for collective bargaining purposes by the Central Bucks Transportation Association (hereinafter "Association" or "Union") and the Parties are negotiating a successor agreement to the one which expired June 30, 2011;

WHEREAS, the District currently outsources the transportation function for about one-half of its student requirements to First Student;

WHEREAS, the District has advised the Association in collective bargaining of its intent to outsource the remaining transportation functions over a period of years;

WHEREAS, the Association has advised the District in collective bargaining that it opposes outsourcing the remaining transportation functions over a period of years, and wishes to negotiate a successor agreement that would protect the remaining bargaining unit employees from involuntary layoffs;

WHEREAS, the expired collective bargaining agreement contains a provision at Article VII, currently obligating the District to maintain the number of bargaining unit positions in effect on September 1, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the District shall be laying off bus drivers effective June 30, 2012.

NOW THEREFORE, the District and Association agree as follows:

1. While the District and Association have not yet finalized any new collective bargaining agreement and remain in status quo, the parties have agreed to amend the status quo effective June 30, 2012 in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement.
2. The parties will continue to negotiate a new collective bargaining agreement under the amended status quo set forth in this Agreement.
3. The District and Association agree that a minimum of forty-four (44) runs shall be subcontracted after June 30, 2012 and therefore forty-four (44) drivers shall be laid off effective June 30, 2012. The District will pay a Five Thousand Dollar (\$5,000) payment to all employees who are laid off. The money shall be deposited in a tax sheltered vehicle. No cash disbursements shall be made. The transitional payment is to assist the employees with obtaining healthcare benefits, either through a Medicare supplement or other means, since medical coverage with the District would terminate August 31, 2012.
4. The transitional payment set forth in paragraph 3 above will apply to all drivers who are laid off, even if the number exceeds the minimum number of forty-four (44) required in paragraph 3 above.
5. The District and Association agree that the District shall layoff drivers in the amount necessary to reach the minimum of forty-four (44). Such layoffs shall occur in accordance with the layoff provisions of the expired collective bargaining agreement.
6. All individuals who are laid off in accordance with paragraph 4 above shall receive a layoff notice from the District to be effective June 30, 2012. The District concedes that their termination is for lack of work due to the subcontracting of their runs and the

District will not oppose any application for unemployment. Should an individual who is laid off be denied unemployment because of the action of the District, that individual may return to work, upon repayment of the \$5,000 transitional amount, and another person will be involuntarily laid off in his or her place, in accordance with the layoff provisions of the expired collective bargaining agreement. If an individual's unemployment benefits are terminated within the first twenty-six (26) weeks of benefits because the individual refuses an offer of employment from First Student, the District will continue payment of the unemployment compensation until the person exhausts all twenty-six (26) weeks of eligibility. Neither the District nor the Association can guarantee any result or compensation from the unemployment system beyond what is specifically stated herein.

7. To be eligible for the transitional payment set forth in paragraph 3 above, the District must receive notice in writing from the employees or the Association on behalf of the employees as to who will be laid off. Said written notice must be received by the District by May 30, 2012 and shall be irrevocable;

8. Additionally, any individual who terminates employment after May 30, 2012 and thereafter, shall result in that run also being removed from the guaranty in Article VII, and said run may then be subcontracted to First Student or any other vendor chosen by the District.


9. For any individual laid off hereunder who seeks employment with First Student, the District agrees to provide whatever information is necessary to assist that individual in obtaining employment from First Student. No laid off individual shall be required to seek or accept an offer of employment from First Student.

10. This Agreement having been ratified by the Association is subject to approval by the Central Bucks School Board. Once approved, the District and Association agree to return to the bargaining table after May 30, 2012, to address the remaining issues that exist including but not limited to wages, healthcare benefits, and subcontracting of additional runs.

Christina Davidson commented on CB schools as a site for summer enrichment courses offered through outside vendors.

III. Discussion Items—Comprehensive Planning—Dr. Weitzel provided an overview of the PDE Comprehensive Plan. This planning process replaces the previous process referred to as Strategic Planning.

The new planning process will be more narrow in its focus and, overall is a three-year plan. The format provided by PDE is less narrative and more of a checklist. We are asked to attest to the degree to which our curriculum, instruction and assessment practices align with the PA Common Core Standards, the PSSAs and the upcoming Keystone exams. We are being asked to complete a Needs Assessment based on Ten Characteristics of High Achieving School Systems. These ten characteristics are converted to a set of systems analysis questions whose answers become the basis for District Action Plans. Additionally, we will use the data obtained from student surveys administered in school over the past couple of months. The surveys were provided by AdvancEd, a company that specializes in school district focused surveys. Much of the Core Foundation has been completed; however, the Needs Assessment and the development of Action Plans will take place between July and mid-October. The committee wants the new superintendent to be part of this phase of the Comprehensive Plan.

We are required to complete the Comprehensive Plan process and submit the plan to the PDE by no later than November 30, 2012.

The technology capital plan for 2012-13 was reviewed with the committee. The long term plan schedules replacement of school computers in a 5 or 6 year cycle. Classrooms of the Future laptops that were originally purchased with a state grant are scheduled for replacement during 2012-13. No state grants are available for laptop replacement at this time. Approximately 1,850 computers will be replaced during the fiscal year. The PC replacement, network equipment, and security hardware/software bring the estimated expenditure to \$1,566,000.

Leasing equipment was also explored. With the current district philosophy of keeping PC's for 5 years or more, leasing is more expensive than purchasing as interest charges accrue and PC's do not have much residual value after a 4-year lease. The committee recommended moving forward with the plan as presented.

(2) 2012-13 Budget Overview

Changes to the budget since the last finance committee meeting were reviewed. The only major change to the budget from the April review was a recommendation to reduce 4.6 additional teaching staff positions at the elementary level due to expected enrollment decline. One teaching position was added for gifted support due to projected class size constraints. The net impact of the staffing adjustments is to reduce teaching positions by an additional 3.6 positions. The recommended reductions for the 2012-13 budget are 2.0 administrative positions, 11.0 teaching positions, and 1.0 support staff position. The additional 3.6 position will save an estimated \$170,000 per year. The recommended millage rate remains at 1.66%.

The committee recommended moving forward with the budget process as described.

(3) Real Estate Tax Bill Collection

A review of real estate bills for the past several years was presented to show a history of the discount real estate taxpayers receive if they qualify for a homestead or farmstead exemption under the provisions of Act 1 of 2006. On average, Central Bucks taxpayers receive a discount of between \$190 to \$205 per year depending on the amount of revenue collected by the state from casinos and the number of eligible homestead/farmstead properties in the district.

(4) **Board Treasurer Position**

Tom McCambridge, Director of Finance, has plans to retire in the fall of 2012. The business office is in the process of transitioning job responsibilities in anticipation of his retirement. One of his responsibilities is to act as the treasurer for the school board. To avoid purchasing two fidelity bonds, one in July and the second in November, Susan Vincent, Assistant Director of Finance, volunteered for the position effective July 1, 2012. The committee recommended placing this item on the board agenda for consideration.

(5) **Other Items**

Other items on the agenda were considered as information for review. Administration needs to refine some of the estimated costs. These items will appear on future committee agendas.

Approval to Adopt the Final Budget for the 2012-2013 School Year in the Amount of \$287,238,850.

It is recommended that the proposed final budget be adopted as the budget for the Central Bucks School District for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012 in the amount of \$287,238,850.

PROPOSED RESOLUTION

A. Adoption of Funding Resolution and School Tax Resolutions for the 2012-13 School Year.

1. Gambling Rebate

Pursuant to Act 1 and as a result of a Gambling Rebate, the assessed value will be reduced by a maximum of \$1,648 which will produce a maximum rebate of \$202.37 per eligible homestead. Pursuant to Act 1 and as a result of a Gambling Rebate, the assessed value will be reduced by a maximum of \$3,296 which will produce a maximum rebate of \$404.74 per eligible farmstead exemption.

2. Real Estate Tax

006.1. ATTENDANCE AT MEETINGS VIA ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS

Section 1. Purpose

65 Pa. C.S.A.
Sec. 701 et seq

The Board of School Directors recognizes that it is a deliberative body and that it is important for Board members to attend meetings to perform the role for which they were elected. It is the preference of the Board to have a quorum physically present for all meetings.

The Board of School Directors recognizes that members may not be physically present at all Board meetings. The Board further recognizes that advances in technology have made it possible for individuals to interact with others from remote locations through the use of speaker phones/teleconferencing and/or videoconferencing.

Section 2. Authority

SC 407

Members of the Board may attend Board meetings or committee meetings and may participate in Board deliberations and actions, by speakerphone/teleconferencing and/or videoconferencing if s/he does not physically attend the meeting. No Board member shall participate remotely more than two times during a calendar year, provided, however that the Board, by majority vote, shall allow a Board member to participate remotely more than two times when conditions or circumstances justify such added remote participation.

Section 3. Requirements

SC 405, 426, 427,
428

Members of the Board who desire to participate in a meeting by means of speaker phone/teleconferencing and/or videoconferencing shall notify the President of the Board, the Board Secretary, and Superintendent at least one (1) business day in advance of the meeting in question.

Members of the Board participating by remote access shall be considered present at all or part of the meeting, and shall be entitled to participate in the meeting, if:

a. Such member is able to hear other members of the Board and members of the public who are recognized by the Board during public comment.

b. The public and other members of the Board are able to hear the member of the Board who is not physically present at the meeting.

c. The determination as to whether the member shall be considered present shall be made by the acting Board Secretary. Each Board member participating from a remote location may be requested by any member of the Board then present to declare that he/she is participating prior to the motion for each item on the agenda.

When any member of the Board participates by remote access, all votes shall be by roll call. If for any reason the remote access, in full or in part with the Board member is terminated or malfunctions before the adjournment of the meeting, the meeting shall continue unless the resultant nonparticipation by the absent member results in the loss of a quorum, in which case the meeting shall be adjourned. Such adjournment shall not affect the validity of such actions taken by the Board prior to adjournment.

Section 4. Responsibility

The Superintendent or his/her designee is authorized and directed to provide speakerphones/teleconferencing and/or videoconferencing facilities sufficient to implement this policy.
