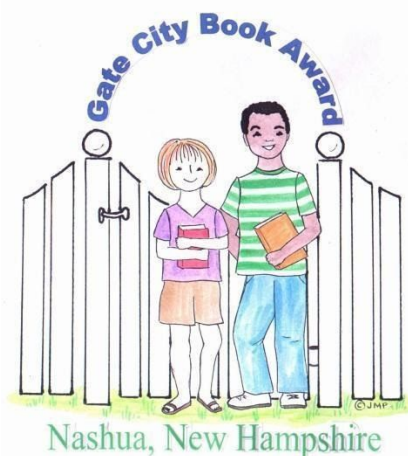


Gate City Book Award Nominees
