FAITH IN EDUCATION

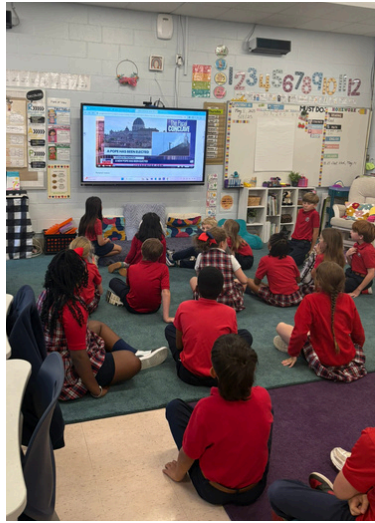
BACKPACK BLESSINGS

According to Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA), the non-profit organization that provides the Measures of Academic Progress tests for our Lower School, St. Anne-Pacelli students in grades Kindergarten-8th outperformed the national norm in every subject tested - Math, Reading, Language Use and Science - during the Winter 2024 and Spring 2025 testing administration. We are so proud of our students and their teachers!



6TH GRADERS PITCH IDEA TO COMPANY CEO



Five Pacelli 6th graders spent a January afternoon pitching an idea to reduce plastic waste to the leaders of Callaway Blue Spring Water. Landon Conner, Noor McClellan, Stephen McGinn, Harper Singleton, and Liam Watson presented their ideas to Callaway Blue Spring Water CEO Edward Callaway and CFO Frank Bonner. Their goal is to reduce the amount of plastics that are dumped in our oceans as well as offer a plant-based alternative to plastic water bottles. Pacelli's Lower School Gifted Teacher Mr. Scott Chandler served as the students' mentor for this project, which is part of an ongoing FIRST LEGO League Competition. The middle schoolers were treated to lunch and got a behind the scenes look at how Callaway Blue Spring Water is bottled. In a *Ledger-Enquirer* article written about the students and their project, Callaway Blue Spring Water CEO Edward Callaway said he was blown away by the students and noted they did a better job than most adults!

STAR STUDENTS

This year's STAR Students are seniors Ebreem Sirleaf and Erin Williams! The STAR Student must have the highest SAT score (Ebreem and Erin tied!) in their class and be ranked in the top 10 percent or top 10 students of their class based on grade point average. STAR Students from our area were recognized on February 5th at a luncheon sponsored by the Rotary Club of Columbus. Ebreem selected High School Science Teacher Lisa Aut as his STAR Teacher; Erin picked High School Social Studies Teacher Wendy McReynolds.



FUTURE DIPLOMATS IN TRAINING

The Columbus State University Model UN (CSUMUN), a program started over 25 years ago, connects local high school students to the work of the United Nations. 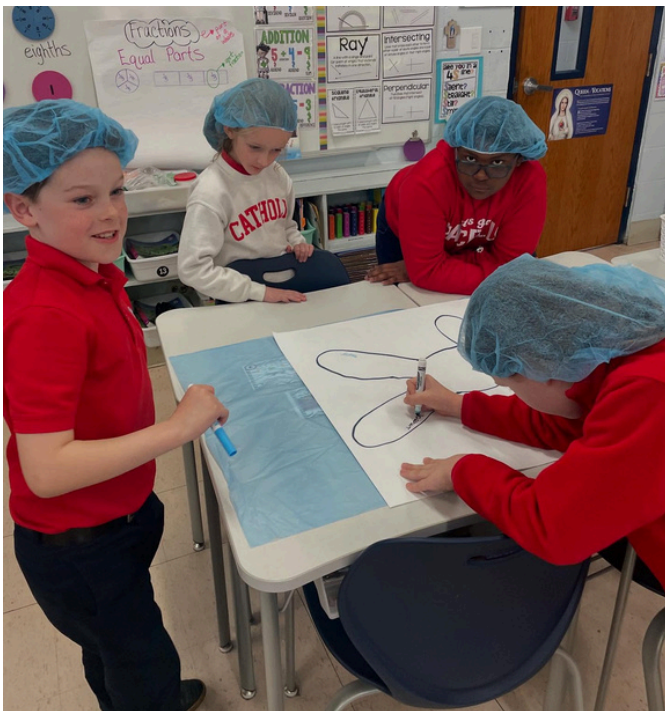

TRIBUTE TO OUR FOUNDERS



Since arriving in 1862, the Sisters of Mercy have shaped Catholic education in Columbus, Georgia, leaving an indelible mark on our community. To commemorate their incredible legacy, St. Anne-Pacelli Catholic School unveiled a special athletic jersey on December 9, 2024 in their honor. The jersey, designed in a striking Marian blue, symbolizes devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, reflecting the faith and values that the Sisters of Mercy have instilled in our school community.

Administrators, faculty, staff and students celebrated the Sisters of Mercy's impact on our school and wished them well in retirement during an all-school ceremony, held on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of Mary. School leaders surprised Sr. Pat Thompson and Sr. Margaret Downing with the school's new Sisters of Mercy jersey. Marian blue is now available as an option in

addition to our school's red, white and navy jerseys for our 16 sports. The Sisters of Mercy jerseys include the Mercy cross on the upper left shoulder and will be worn on special game days by our high school Vikings. High School Principal Carolyn Brewster said, "...This will serve as a visual reminder for our community of this holy group of women."

For the first time in school history, our Lady Vikings Volleyball team earned a state championship! The Lady Vikings swept crosstown rival Brookstone in the GIAA AAA finals on October 15, 2024, at The Heritage School to win the title. This came after a 27-3 regular season record. The Lady Vikings Volleyball team ended the year ranked No. 8 in the state of Georgia, across all classifications.



Our Lady Vikings Flag Football team pulled off a three-peat after earning a 30-0 win against Georgia Christian from Valdosta in the GIAA State Championship Flag Football game on November 21, 2024. Coached by Zach Corcoran (Pacelli Class 2008), our Lady Vikings have now won three consecutive state championships.

"I'm just super proud of our team but especially our seniors who helped build this team," said Corcoran. "Back-to-back-to-back, it all started from their freshman year. They've been a huge part of our players who are producing now but also leading the next generation."

Corcoran said this state championship game was extra special, since it was played at Georgia Southern University, his alma mater.

Pacelli's eSports team also earned a state championship for the third year in a row! High School Math Teacher and eSports Coach Mr. Joseph Kim (Pacelli Class of 2013) said, "Hurst O'Shields, Zachary Farmer, and Hayden Idell, all senior varsity Smash Brothers players, have been carrying the Vikings eSports team for the past three years. It is not without hard work and dedication that these players never gave up. It is not without humility and reflection that these players continued to improve. And it is not without each other that these players kept each other's head in the game."





Four Pacelli wrestlers and a track and field high jumper are 2025 individual state champions! Junior Sophia Chervenak won the 130 pound state title and became the first 3-time state champion in GIAA history; freshman Jackie Ringrose started her high school career on a high note by winning the 120 pound state championship; junior Grace Rogers upset a 2-time defending state champion with a 3rd period pin, winning the 145 pound GIAA State Championship and was named the Wrestler of the Year; and senior Nicholas Nugent won the 132 pound title with a 3rd period pin to seal a come-from-behind victory. All four won their state titles in February 2025. Sophomore Michael Rowe claimed 1st place in the high jump with a 6'4" jump at the GIAA State Class AAA Meet in May 2025.



Pacelli's boys' and girls' basketball teams won their second straight state championships on March 1, 2025, during the Georgia Independent Athletic Association Class AAAA finals in the Lumpkin Center at Columbus State University. Both teams beat Athens Christian in the title game. The girls overcame a 15-point deficit in the second quarter to prevail 39-38, and the boys dominated in a 75-54 blowout.



Our Lady Vikings Soccer team defeated crosstown rival Brookstone 2-1 in double overtime to earn the first girls' soccer state championship for our school on May 27, 2025. Our boys' soccer team earned its 2nd state championship on May 28, 2025, defeating Stratford Academy 2-1.



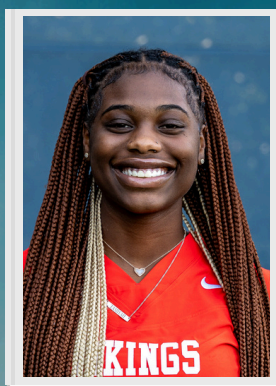

Once A Viking, Always A Viking

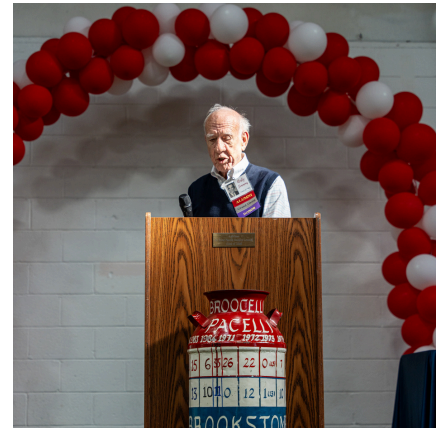

A Vikings Football coach, school board member, and generous supporter of our school, **Roger Beck** has been coaching football at Pacelli since 2001. He is responsible for many recent campus improvements, including Deimel Field and The Beck Center for Academic and Athletic Success. He also is a devoted donor to our school's Adopt-A-Viking program, removing the financial barriers for students to receive a St. Anne-Pacelli education.

Giorgio Hiatt, Pacelli Class of 1991, is a three-time wrestling state champion who brought about an enormous love for the sport to our school. While wrestling was his primary sport, he was also an All-Bi-City soccer player and a standout kicker for our Vikings Football team. In 1995, he was awarded the Page One Athletics Award. After 10 years as the founding pastor of a multi-ethnic church in Charlotte, North Carolina, he has served as the senior pastor of Redeemer Presbyterian Church in Winston-Salem for the last 12 years.

Dr. Bernard Russell Simmons, or as many know him, Rusty Simmons, Pacelli Class of 1962, received the Patrick A. McCauley Memorial Award as the Most Valuable Football Player for the 1960 season. Here's a really cool fact: His grandson, Bridge Pepper, Pacelli Class of 2021, was named the MVP 60 years later, in 2020! As a player, Rusty played various positions in order to strengthen our school's early football squad - from quarterback, to guard, to tackle. He wore jersey 74 and embraced the title of Captain. In addition to being a member of our school's 1961 Undefeated Football Team, Rusty served as Class President during his senior year. He went on to attend the University of Georgia for undergraduate studies, and then graduated from the Medical College of Georgia in 1970. He is now retired, but practiced in Columbus for a number of decades and specialized in Urology. He and his late wife, Cissie, had four children and many grandchildren, including three grandsons who are also Viking alumni.

Pacelli's **2002 State Championship Girls Softball Team** had a 25-9 record for the 2002 season. The team was composed of Brooke Bucholtz, Katie Bucholtz, Mandy Cotto, Catharine Crenshaw Pellegrino, Jennifer Downey, Dalin Gillis, Kim Klugh, Kelsey McGee, Jessika Nelson, Margaret O'Brien, Amy Prather, Rachel Spivey and Katie Tuel. The Lady Vikings progressed to the Georgia High School Association Single A Fast Pitch Finals held at South Commons October 31-November 2, 2022. They beat Georgia Military College, Gordon Lee and Brookstone, before beating Bremen 1-0 in the final game. They were coached by Lonny Arrington, Leo Valero and Tim Downey.

Our first Distinguished Alumni Award recipient is **John Cobis**. He and his seven sisters all attended Pacelli. John, a middle child, graduated in 1976. He received a bachelor's degree in English Education from Columbus State University, a master's degree in educational administration from Trinity College, a specialist's degree in leadership from the University of Georgia and a master's degree in theological studies from Spring Hill College. He served as principal of his alma mater from 1997 to 2000, before he left Columbus and helped found and serve as the first principal of Our Lady of Mercy Catholic High School in Fayetteville, Georgia. Before retiring, John spent 16 years teaching in the Muscogee County School District at Northside High School where he was recognized as a Top 10 semifinalist for Teacher of the Year, a Harvard Fellow, two-time STAR Teacher and Sara Spano Top Teacher Award. John's devotion to God is evident in how he lives his faith, something that was instilled in him by his parents Joe and Betty Cobis, who bought their home on Kay Circle to be close to both the school and church. As a St. Anne Church parishioner, John has served through a variety of ministries including, but definitely not limited to, Adult Education, prison ministry and St. Anne Community Outreach. He was selected by Fr. Scott Winchel as the 2024 Margot Bradley Service Award Recipient for St. Anne Parish at the Deimel Legacy Ball. He continues to give back to his alma mater by his ever-present support. In recent years, John has served on the GRACE Scholars, now Georgia GOAL Scholarship Committee, helping to educate the community about the incredible opportunity a gift to this program provides students seeking a Catholic education. As a founding member of the Eugenio Pacelli Legacy Society, he has committed to make a gift to his alma mater through his estate.

Larry Green is our 2024 Doug Harris Spirit of a Viking Award recipient. Coach Green is someone who has spent two decades devoting himself to developing student-athletes into responsible young men and women, and the last 10 years here at St. Anne-Pacelli. He currently coaches two different sports - football and softball - and is not afraid to roll up his sleeves and do the work to get things done. He carries himself in a quiet manner, and many may not see all the "extra" things he does in support of our student-athletes and school. As a tribute to Doug Harris, each year, the Spirit of a Viking Award is presented. During the years that his children, Russell and Allison attended Pacelli, Doug was instrumental in making sure that our Homecoming Bonfire and the Vikings Booster Club Boston Butt sales were successful. That's because Doug embraced the importance of building relationships and developing a strong sense of community and the impact he made on the lives of our student-athletes is not to be forgotten. Doug Harris passed away in September 2009 after battling cancer. Our annual Homecoming Bonfire is named in memory of Doug, and each year we present the Spirit of a Viking Award to a person who demonstrates the same selfless spirit of volunteerism to our athletic program that Doug did for 10 years.

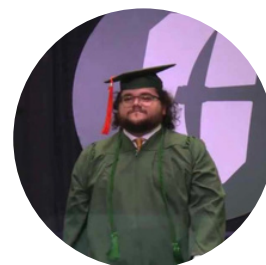

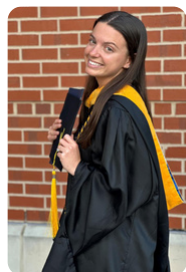

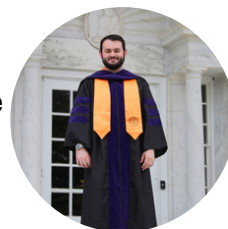
