Exam Certification

Georgetown ISD utilizes two vendors, University of Texas and AVANT, whose exams meet the criteria set by the State Board of Education (SBOE) that the examination:

- Is aligned to all assessable TEKS for the course;
- Has not been published and is not publicly available;
- Will only be administered in a secure environment under standardized conditions by a school district or institution of higher education; and
- Has been evaluated to ensure:
 - Test scores can be interpreted as indicators of what the test is intended to measure; and
 - Consistency of test results across testing conditions.

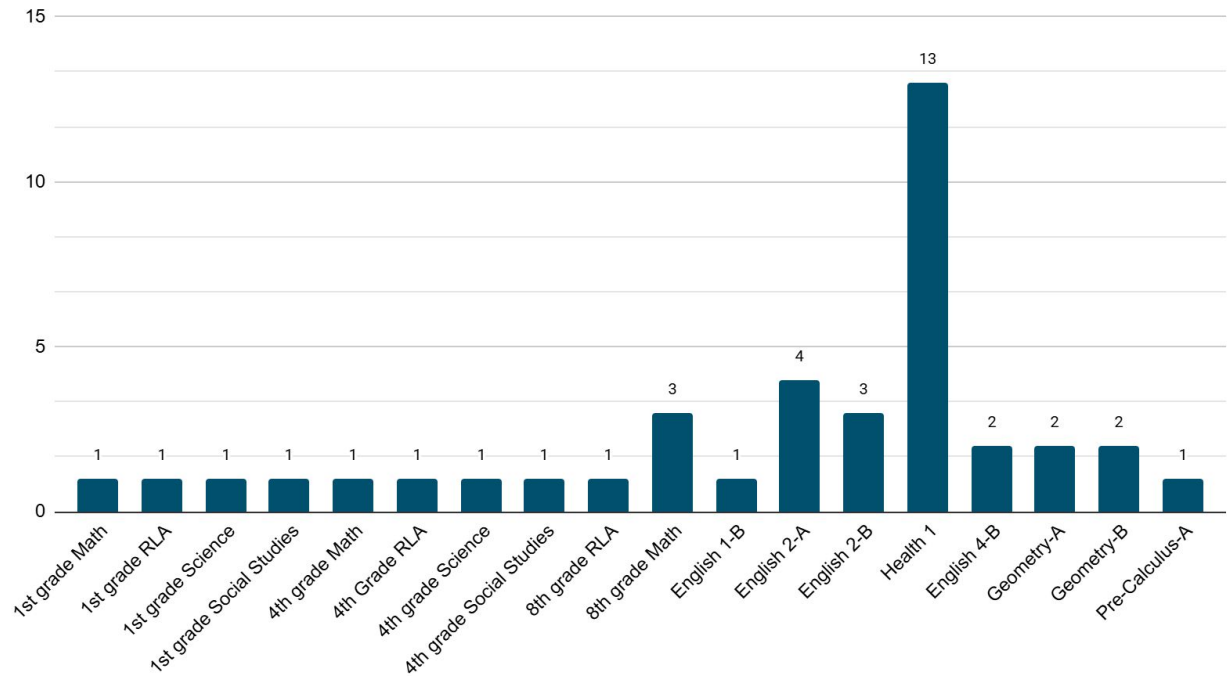

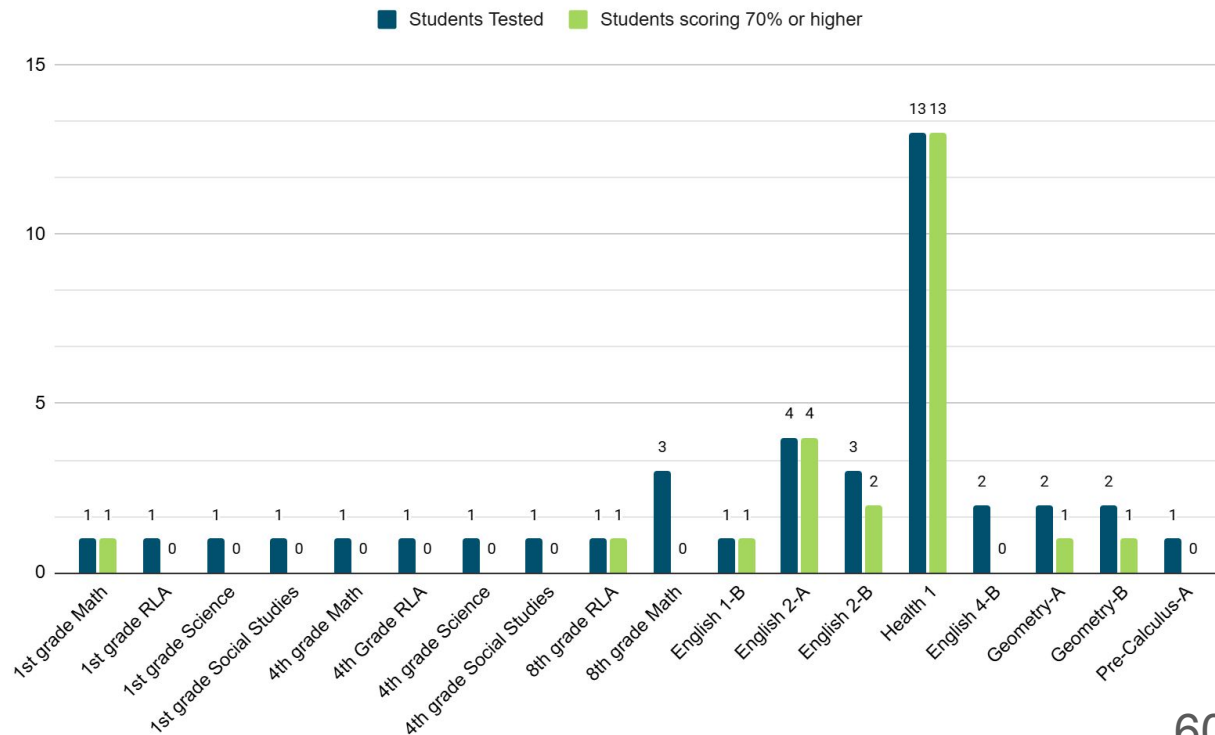

Number of Students Tested 2024-2025

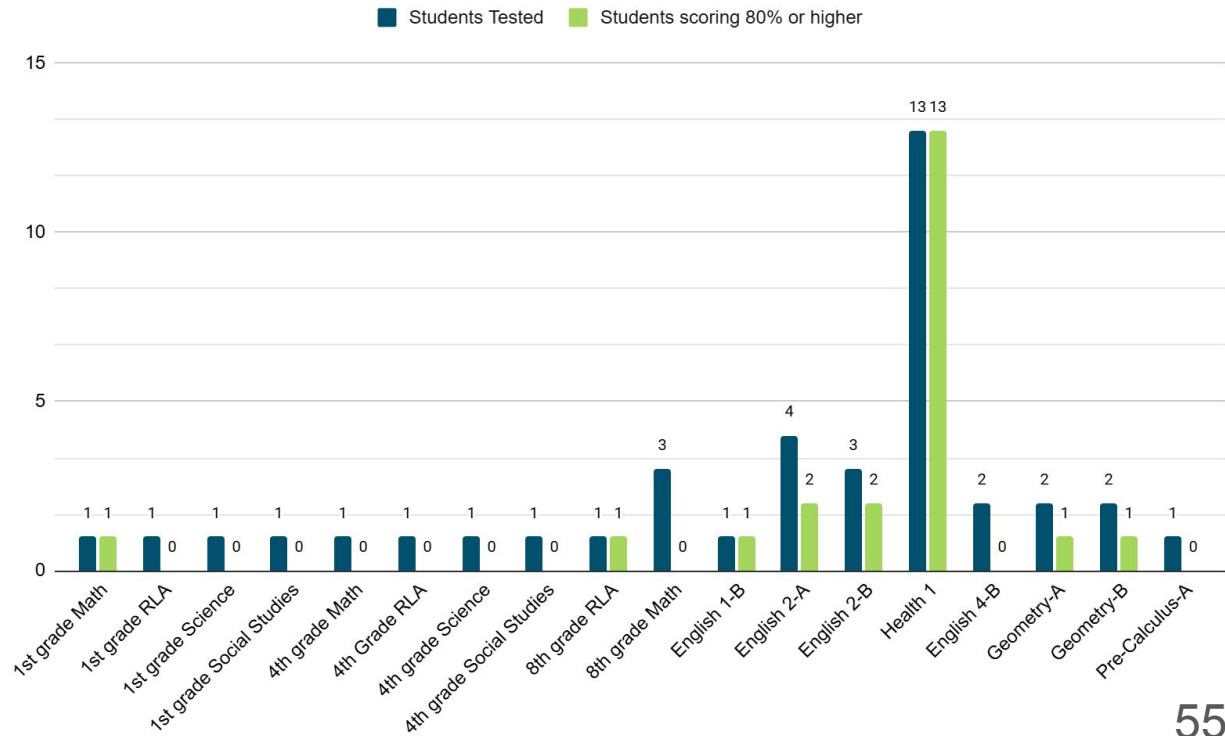


Students scoring 70% or higher: UT High School



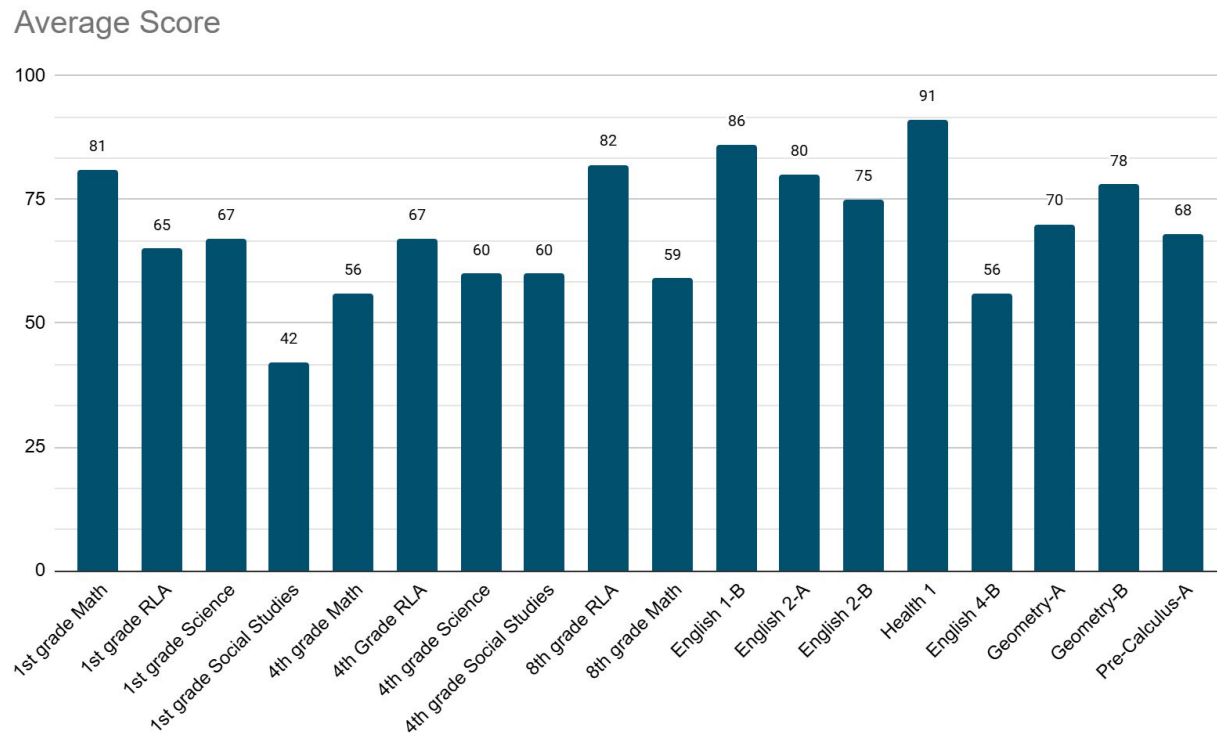

Students scoring 80% or higher: UT High School

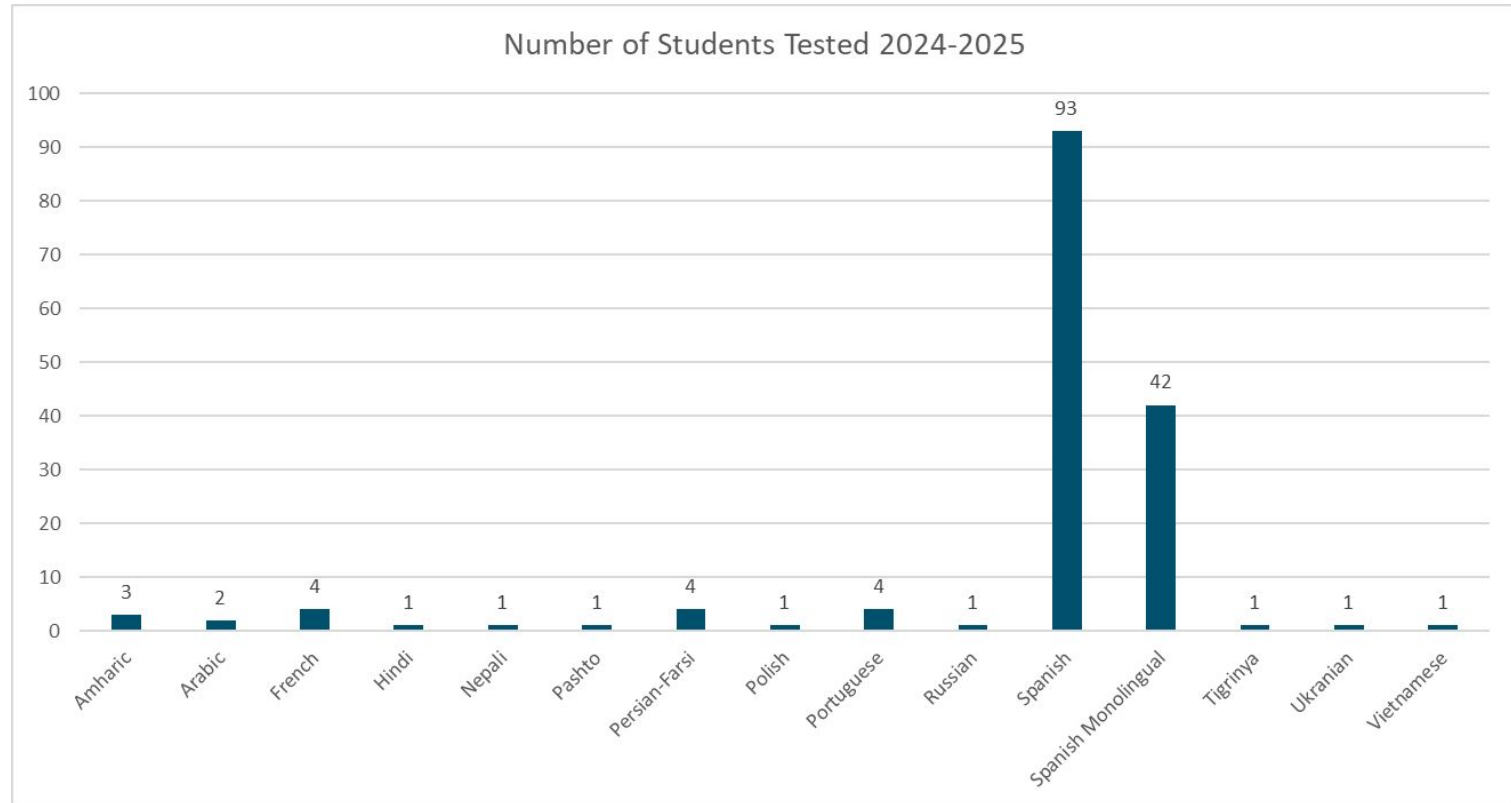

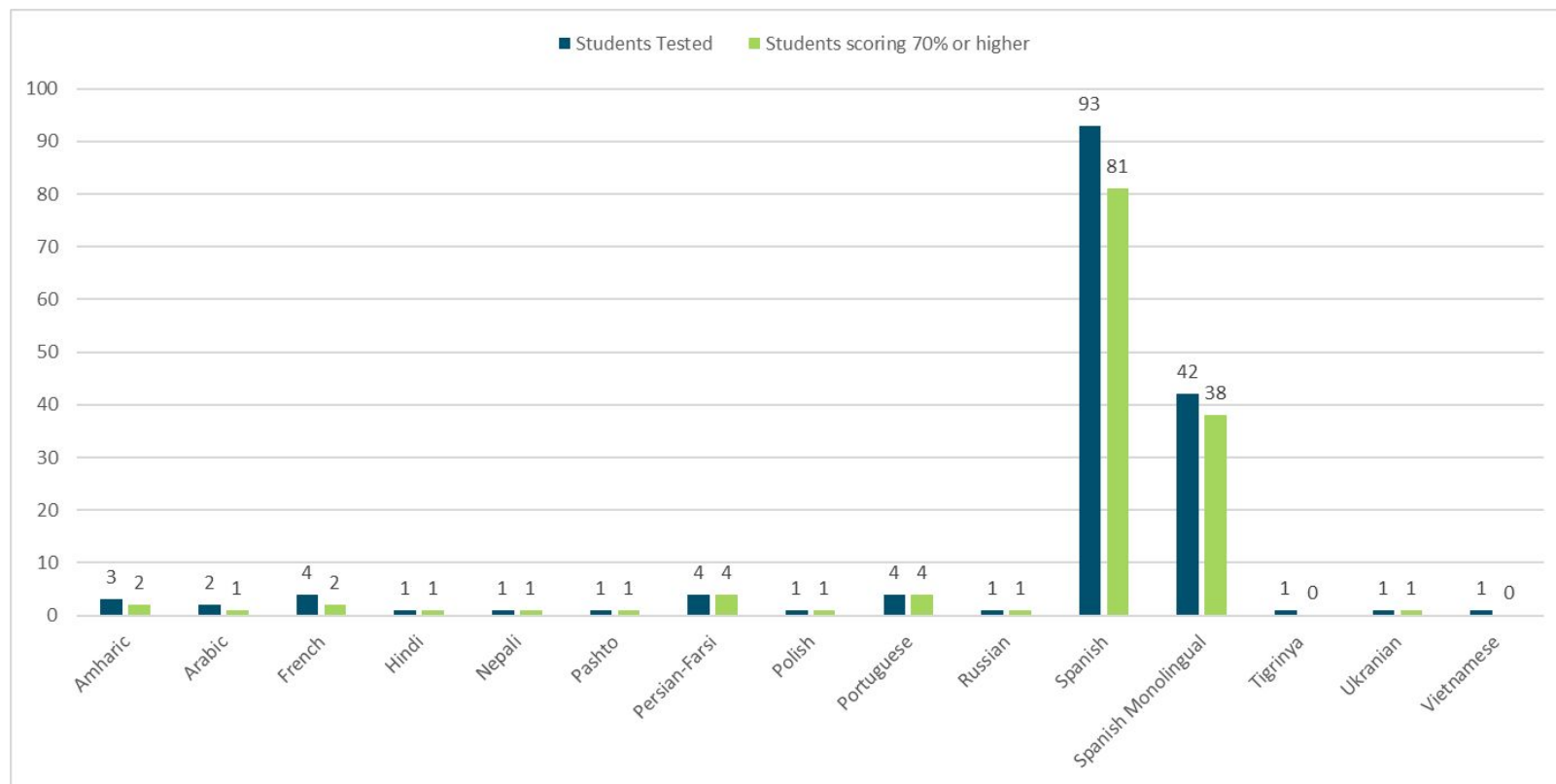
Average score for all students who took each exam: UT High School



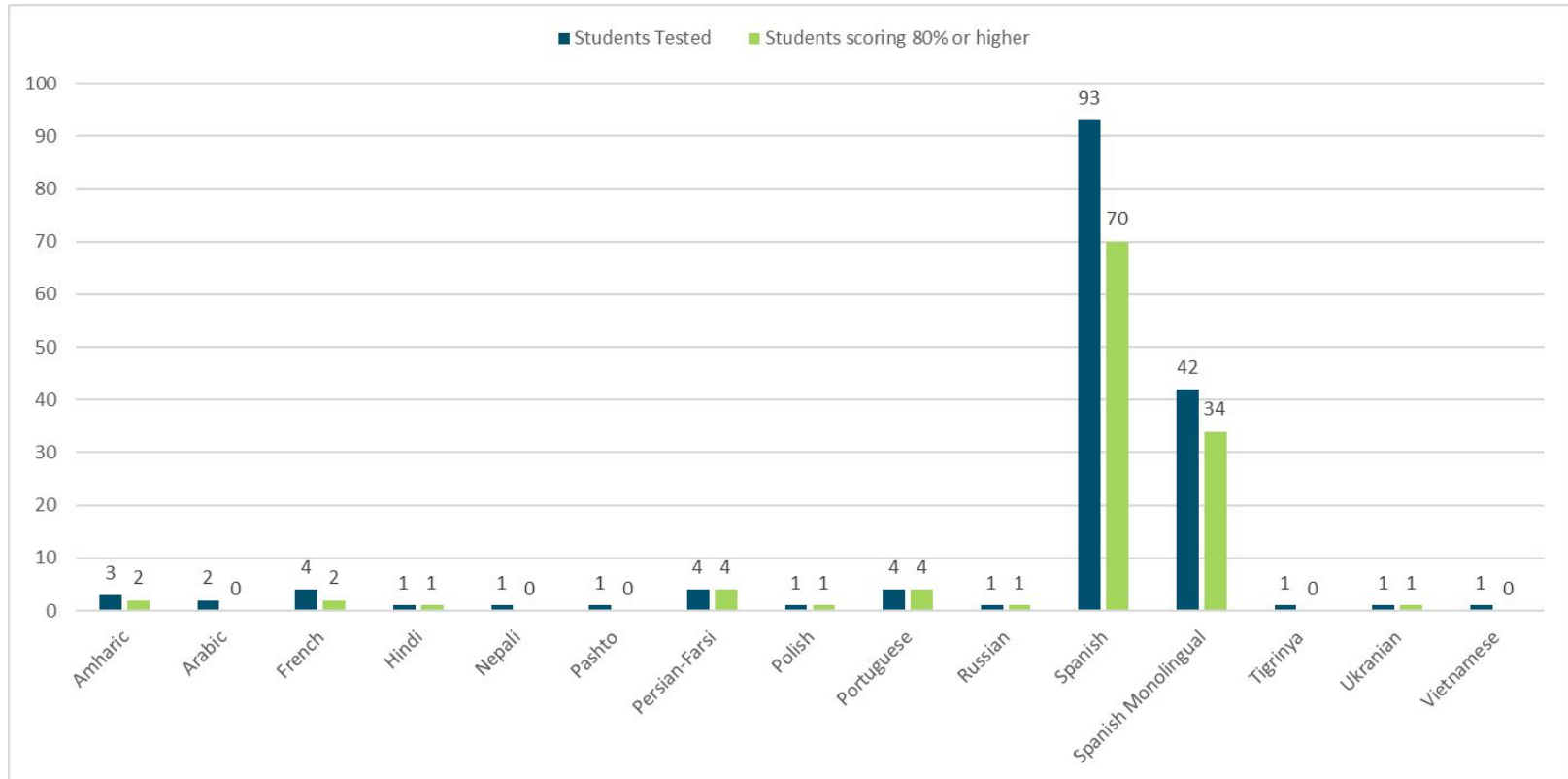
Number of students who took each examination: AVANT



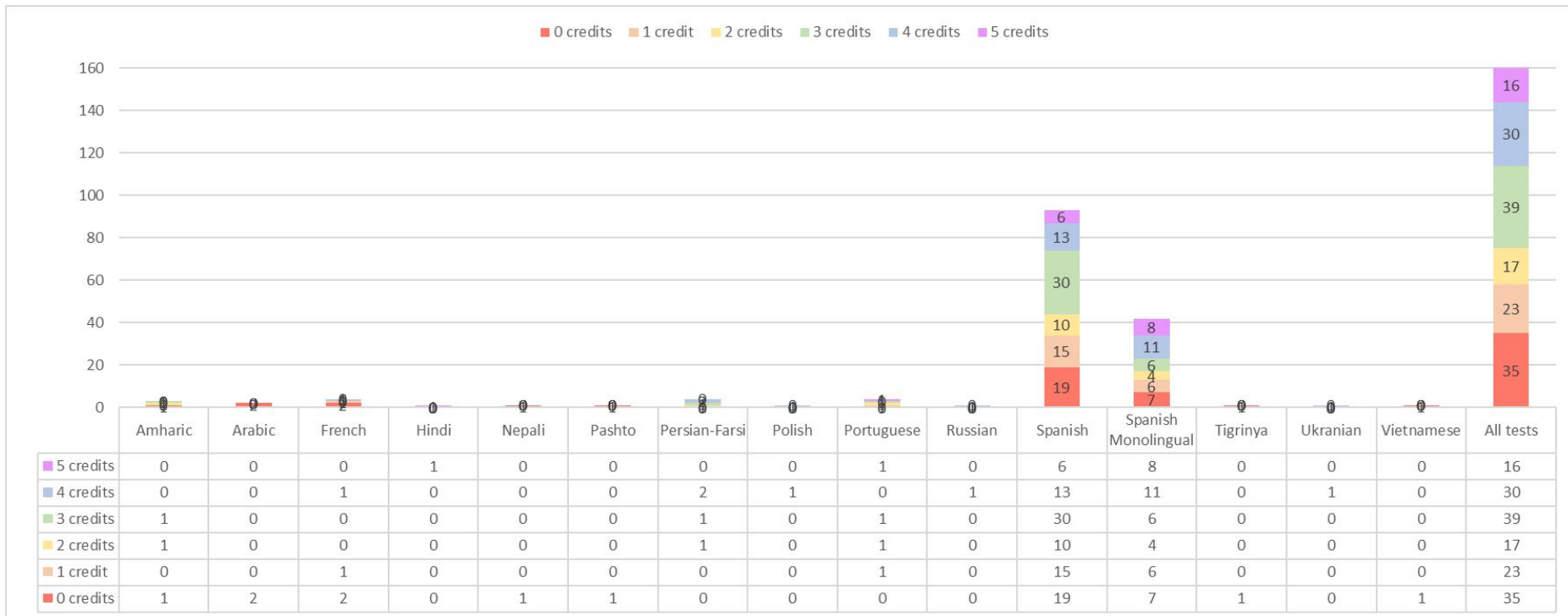
Students scoring 70% or higher: AVANT

District Summary

During the 2024-2025 school year, we administered 200 tests and awarded 146 students 395 credits. 73% of students tested earned one or more credits.

This is an increase from the 2023-2024 school year, when we administered 307 tests and awarded 201 students 508 credits. 65% of students tested earned one or more credits.
