

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Superintendent shall not allow: Teachers in PK-2nd grade to fail in reaching and maintaining the district expectation of a high quality teacher.

- (1.1) The percentage of teachers in PK-2nd grade to reach and maintaining the district expectation of a high-quality teacher in regard to the Reading Academy will increase from 70% to 90% by August 2026.
 - (1.2) The percentage of teachers in PK-2nd grade to reach and maintain the district expectation of a high-quality teacher in regard to being fully certified will increase from 75% to 90% by August 2026

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Superintendent shall not allow: The number of Dual and CTE courses to decrease. (Baseline 2021)

- (2.1) The percentage of Dual courses will increase from 10 to 16 by August 2026.
- (2.2) The percentage of CTE courses will increase from 18 to 24 by August 2026.

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Superintendent shall not allow: Ineffective communication between Board, district employees, and community stakeholders.

(3.1) The communication between Board, district employees, and community stakeholders will increase from 3 methods of communication to 6 methods of communication per year by August 2026.

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Superintendent shall not allow: Teacher turnover to increase.

(4.1) The percentage of teacher turn over will decrease from 22% to 15% by August 2026.

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Superintendent shall not allow: A collaborative partnership between home, school, and community to deteriorate.

(5.1) The collaborative partnership between home, school, and community will increase from 6 events to 12 events per year by August 2026.
