Dear Families,

Summer is just around the corner! As in years past, the South Euclid-Lyndhurst City School District has an exciting summer reading initiative for students entering Kindergarten through 6th grade. This year, we are thrilled to partner once again with the South Euclid-Lyndhurst Branch Library for the **2025 Summer Reading Challenge: *Color Your World***.

We encourage all K-6 families to participate in this fun and rewarding program. **Pre-registration begins May 1st** and can be completed [online](#) or in person at the library. The reading challenge officially kicks off on **June 2nd**.

Students may track their reading in two ways:

- **Online using [Beanstack](#)**, or
- **With a consumable game board**, available for pickup at the library.

Reading includes listening to a story read aloud by someone else or enjoying an audiobook—every minute counts!

Participants will have opportunities to earn **exciting prizes**:

- **Midpoint Prize**: After 5 days of reading (up to 5 midpoint prizes).
- **Completion Prize & Grand Prize Entry**: After 10 days of reading (up to 5 grand prize entries).
- **Bonus Grand Prize Entry**: Attend 5 library programs and log attendance on your game board.

Students can bring their completed game boards to the library, where staff will input their reading progress.

In addition, the library will host “**Summer Fun for Everyone**” **STEAM drop-in programs** from **June 3rd to July 28th**, Monday–Thursday, 1:30-2:30 p.m. and 5:30-6:30 p.m., for students entering grades 1–6.

To support your child’s reading journey:

- Use grade-level **graphic organizers** ([K–2](#) or [3–6](#)) to guide thinking and comprehension.
- Explore our **suggested reading lists** (for grades [K–2](#) and [3–6](#)). While these titles are recommended, students are welcome to read anything that interests them. If they can read it or listen to it, it counts!

Free or low-cost eBook access options include:

- [Epic!](#) – Free and paid versions available.
- The South Euclid-Lyndhurst Library – Use the [Libby](#) or [Hoopla](#) app with a library card and PIN.

As a community, we are dedicated to building lifelong readers. Thank you for partnering with us to keep students engaged and inspired all summer long.
