



## MDCA Lunch Program 2025-2026

Mount Dora Christian Academy strives to offer all students nutritious and delicious meals that promote their academic and physical well-being. Consistent with this mission, we offer a free or reduced lunch program for all eligible students (based on need).

### Program Overview

The MDCA lunch program consists of a variety of meal options to cater to the diverse tastes and dietary needs of our students. Some key features of our program include the following:

- **Nutritionally Balanced Meals:** Our meals are designed to ensure that students receive well-balanced, healthy lunches every day.
- **Menu Variety:** We offer a rotating menu that includes a wide range of options, from classic favorites to new and exciting dishes.
- **Free and Reduced Lunch Eligibility:** Students eligible for free or reduced lunch receive one mainline lunch daily. Additional options are available for an extra charge.
- **A la carte Line:** This is a separate line from the mainline lunch and is available for secondary students. A la carte is not eligible for the free/reduced lunch program.
