



Acceptable Use Agreement for Students

As a district with a carted and one-to-one initiative using technology in the classroom, all students must review and abide by the “Computer and Network Guidelines” found [here](#) on the district’s website in the Parents and Student section.

Please review the statements below, by proceeding, you acknowledge the receipt of and agree to abide by the Acceptable Use Agreement. The Agreement is available for reference on the [district's website](#).

Use of the network is a privilege, The purpose of this Acceptable Use Agreement is to ensure that students use school-provided technology and internet resources responsibly, safely, and ethically.

Acceptable Use

Students must:

- Use technology for educational purposes only;
- Follow teachers’ instructions when using devices and the internet;
- Respect copyright laws and properly cite sources;
- Use appropriate language and behavior online;
- Keep personal information private and protect passwords;
- Use **AI** Tools for learning, research, and idea generation when permitted by the teacher;
- Use **AI** Tools to maintain a positive, responsible, unbiased, and ethical use of the technology for education;

Unacceptable Use

Students may NOT:

- Use technology for cyberbullying, harassment, or threats;
- Access, create, or share inappropriate content (e.g., violent, hateful, or explicit material);
- Attempt to bypass security settings or access restricted areas;
- Download, install, or modify software without permission;
- Use another person’s account or share login credentials;
- Change network configurations;
- Add non-authorized (personal devices) to the network, including use of VPNs;
- Use technology for commercial purposes [according to Policy GKD (Local)], product advertisement purposes or political lobbying; will not damage, delete, or modify district, staff or student files, programs, or disks;
- Use district-owned devices to access TikTok or any other applications or services developed or provided by ByteDance Limited, or an entity owned by ByteDance Limited;

- Not participate in chat rooms, blogs, message boards, or forums (unless it is for educational purposes and under teacher supervision); understand non-compliance or misuse of network privileges may result in disciplinary action or criminal prosecution;
- Use **AI** tools for dishonestly or plagiarize on assignments'
- Use **AI** to complete assignments, essays, or projects without teacher approval;
- Use **AI** to generate false information, spread misinformation, or impersonate others;
- Use **AI** to bypass academic integrity (e.g., cheating, plagiarism, or automated homework completion);
- Download or sign up for any online resource or application without prior approval from their teacher or other District administrator;
- Damage electronic communications systems or electronic equipment, including knowingly or intentionally introducing a virus to a device or network, or not taking proper security steps to prevent a device or network from becoming vulnerable;

Security and Privacy

- I understand student use shall be monitored at all times by SFISD staff.
- Students should report any security concerns or suspicious behavior to a teacher or administrator.

Agreement

I have read the district's technology guidelines, associated administrative regulations, and this user agreement, and I agree to abide by their provisions, including the district's guidelines for responsible online behavior and use of social networking websites.
