Safety Complaints/Records and Reports

Transportation Complaints

All complaints concerning school transportation safety will be made to the Transportation Specialist. The Specialist will maintain a written record of all such complaints and will conduct appropriate investigations of the allegations.

The Superintendent of Schools or designee shall make a written report of the circumstances of any accident within their jurisdiction and knowledge, involving a motor vehicle and any pedestrian who is a student, which occurs at a designated school bus stop or in the immediate vicinity thereof, to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles within ten days thereafter on a form prescribed by the Commissioner.

The Superintendent will provide the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles with a copy of the written record of complaints within thirty (30) days of the end of the school year.
