REQUEST FOR WRITTEN PERMISSION OF ENTRY AND USE

Bellingham Public Schools may give written permission of entry and use to a covered offender to enter and remain on the legal premises of the district at particular times and for lawful purposes, including, but not limited to, conducting business, or participating in educational or recreational activities. Any request for written permission of entry and use of school district premises must be clearly stated in a written document, approved by the principal and response must be personally served on the covered offender. If the covered offender violates the conditions of entry and use contained in a written document personally served on the offender by the district, the covered offender may be charged and prosecuted for a felony offense as provided in RCW <u>9A.44.196</u>. The covered offender is responsible for maintaining a copy of this letter.
