Dear First Grade Families,

Welcome to Mrs. Parra's First Grade class! I am looking forward to meeting you and your child so that together, we can build a positive home-school connection.

The FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL is on Tuesday, July 29th. Breakfast will be served at 8:00 am and students can enter through the side door near the parking lot to the cafeteria. A staff member will walk students to their classrooms after breakfast.

Our classroom number is A6. School gates open at 8:20 and class starts at 8:30 am. Students will enter through the front gate or through the back gate by the park to go to their classrooms. I will be there to pick up my students at the FRONT GATE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL. Please be prepared to say goodbye to your First Grader at the gate.

During dismissal time at 2:35, I will walk students to the front gate. Please be sure that your child is aware of the pick up plan after school (who will pick them up, wait for sibling, etc.) It is really important to follow all after school pick up procedures for safety reasons. A staff member will walk your child to the car safely if you are at the pick up area. If you are walking to the gate to pick up your child, please park your car in the lot or on the side of the street and use the crosswalk. If your child has an older sibling in grades 4th-6th, they can wait at the front gate with their sibling. Also, please let me know if your child will be going to the after school program. For late pick-ups (after 2:50), those students will be waiting in the office.

## Students will NEED TO BRING these items on the FIRST DAY of SCHOOL (other supplies will be provided in class):

- -BACKPACK (please do not send backpacks with wheels)
- -2 POCKET FOLDER (NO BINDER PLEASE)
- -CHROMEBOOK and CHARGER
- -WATER BOTTLE

It is very important that students bring their **charged**Chromebook and charger to school everyday as we will be using the Chromebooks daily. Students will also need to use their Chromebook at home because learning apps will be assigned as homework.

I also HIGHLY RECOMMEND that students wear Velcro or slip on shoes to school (no open toe shoes) so they will not get easily distracted with the shoelaces.

I will be using an app called **Class Dojo** for our parent-teacher communication. It can be accessed through your smartphone or your computer. Class Dojo is a great way for you to receive class updates, sign up for conferences and send private messages to me. I will be sending directions on how to join Class Dojo within the first week of school. You can also contact me through my email at aparra@lodiusd.net
