Optional Accident and Health Insurance Program Information
2025-2026 School Year

Student health and safety is a priority in the Napa Valley Unified School District. Student accidents do still occur and can result in the need for a student to receive medical treatment (ambulance transport, surgery, hospitalization, etc.).

The Napa Valley Unified School District does not assume responsibility for the cost of medical treatment required by a student due to an accident that occurs on a school campus or during a school event. . As a service, NVUSD has joined with other districts in offering you access to a low cost, voluntary purchase of student accident/health insurance. This program is arranged and administered by Myers-Stevens & Toohey & Co., Inc. a firm that has specialized in student accident and health coverage for over 40 years.

Several plans are available with rates for the entire school year starting at just \$24. You select a plan that simply offers the coverage to school-related injuries only (including sports) or opt for a more comprehensive plan that provides full protection. You also have the option to participate in a plan that offers student sickness and accident coverage (recommended if your child has no other health insurance) and pharmacy discount programs for your entire family.

Families covered by Myers-Stevens & Toohey & Co., can seek care from any doctor or hospital, and also have access to an extensive network of medical providers with discounted charges. Seeking care through contracted providers may further reduce your out-of-pocket costs, particularly if your child needs surgery or hospitalization.

While your child is eligible to enroll at any time, you are encouraged to consider early enrollment to get maximum value from the plan selected. **Once processing is completed, an ID card verifying coverage will be mailed home to you.**
