A student is considered tardy if they are not in their assigned class when the bell rings. Excessive tardies will be addressed as follows:


1 - 4	Verbal warning/Teacher Notify Parent after 3rd tardy.

Buyer further understands that all outstanding payments must be made by November 7, 2025. If not, the outstanding balance will be turned into a fine and a 10% processing fee will be added. The buyer agrees to pay this fine/finance charge should a balance exist on November 8, 2025.

Buyer finally understands that the student must satisfy the Dance/Event Contract in order to attend school dances and events. This means the student's school account must be paid in full prior to any release of dance tickets (including any club charges and/or library fines), student's attendance record must be satisfactory (example: no more than 10 day absences for any reason), and the student must not have any severe disciplinary infractions (example: fighting, weapons, drugs/alcohol, etc.).
