An automated phone call occurs when a negative balance appears on a student's account. If a student account exhausts the grace period/charge limit, the student must select a peanut butter and jelly or toasted cheese sandwich entree for lunch and/or a cereal entrée for breakfast until the negative balance is paid. A la Carte / snack items are <u>not</u> available for charging.</p> <p>FREE/REDUCED-PRICE MEAL PROGRAM We encourage you to complete the USDA free/reduced price meal application if you feel economic hardship exists. Applications expire each year and must be submitted each year.
