The Pennsylvania Department of Health mandates health examinations and immunizations in specific grades during your child's school career according to 23 PA Code § 23.2(a) and § 23.2(c) (physical exam) and 23 PA Code § 23.3(a) and § 23.3(b)(dental exam).

In addition, if your child is a new student and/or has incomplete health records, your child will need to complete the required examination(s) and immunizations. The physical and dental examinations must be dated no earlier than September 1st of the previous school year. **IMMUNIZATION requirements need to be submitted; reviewed and completed by the Certified School Nurse PRIOR to your child's first day of school.**

Grade 3	Dental Examination
Grade 6	Physical Examination with Scoliosis; Updated Health History
Grade 7	Dental Examination, Scoliosis; Immunizations: Tdap and Meningococcal (MCV4) # 1

****If a Tdap is given before ages 11-12, this cannot be accepted for the adolescent Tdap****

Grade 9	Updated Health History
Grade 11	Physical Examination
Grade 12	Immunization: Meningococcal (MCV4) # 2.

New Student (any grade) and/or Incomplete Health Records:

Physical Exam
Dental Examination
Scoliosis Screening
Health History
Immunizations

Parents/Guardians are encouraged to have the physical/dental examinations performed by their child's Pennsylvania Licensed Healthcare provider, since they are aware of your child's health history and status. These examinations are at the parents/guardians expense and are **to be submitted to the child's nurses office by December 1st of your child's current school year.**

PHYSICALS: If you prefer, upon parent/guardian request and permission, the school physician will complete the physical examination during the school year at the expense of the school district.

DENTALS: If the dental examination is not submitted by December 1st, your child will automatically be scheduled with the school dentist during the school year at the district expense.
