The School and Its Mission

The Inter-Community School Zurich (ICS) is a distinctive international non-profit school where excellent teachers, strong community ties, and an intimate, single-campus setting create an environment for every child to thrive. For 65 years, we have cultivated an inclusive, nurturing environment where *small is beautiful*: our intentionally moderate size fosters strong connections, meaningful relationships, and a profound sense of belonging among students, families, and faculty alike.

Situated on a single, welcoming campus in a beautiful residential area of Zurich, ICS is deeply rooted in the local community while serving a diverse international population. With approximately 800 multilingual learners aged 24 months to 18 years and representing more than 50 nationalities, we blend global perspectives with local engagement — including German language study from Preschool to Grade 10 to help students fully participate in their surroundings.

Our mission is clear:

"At ICS we are committed to providing a supportive and enabling learning environment in which all members of the community are challenged to achieve their individual potential, encouraged to pursue their passions, and expected to fulfil their responsibilities."

We do this with the help of excellent, experienced teachers — from more than 25 nationalities — dedicated to high standards, holistic development, and the International Baccalaureate curriculum. ICS is the only school in Zurich to offer all three main IB programmes and the city's only Round Square school, part of a global network dedicated to character education through the IDEALS: Internationalism, Democracy, Environmentalism, Adventure, Leadership, and Service. Our student-led Round Square Action Group drives local and global initiatives, while international exchanges — over 100 in the past 15 years — further develop leadership, character, and global understanding.

While known for academic excellence, "Our Kind of Education" is **Bold**, **Balanced and Creative**. Our students thrive not only through rigorous academics, but also through performances, activities, and over 55 sports and teams — all within a safe, supportive, and wellbeing-oriented environment.

A unique example of our commitment to global citizenship is *The Saathi ProjectTM* — a formalised, strategic partnership between ICS, Shree Mangal Dvip School (SMD) in Nepal, and Kathmandu University. Building on a two-decade relationship, this whole-school initiative supports educational access for the children of the Himalayas while fostering deep intercultural exchange. From CAS to service learning, curriculum to teacher development, *The Saathi ProjectTM* empowers ICS students to engage meaningfully with the world — not as observers, but as compassionate changemakers.

We are also advancing a **strategic campus development project** to expand and enhance our facilities, ensuring we can offer even more outstanding learning opportunities for every student — all on our single, connected campus.

Looking ahead to the next century, ICS is ambitious: we will continue to grow thoughtfully, develop new strategies, and build for the future while preserving what makes us special — a small, connected, purpose-driven learning community, deeply rooted in Zurich.
