



Shoe Policy

Updated July 2025

Shoes must be worn as the manufacturer intended, laces tied and with the heel of the shoe covering the heel of the foot. For both boys and girls, only the following uniform shoes are acceptable:

- Bucks (Dark Brown Only)
- Penny Loafers (Dark Brown or Cordovan Only)
- Saddle Oxfords (Girls only, Black/White only)
- Docksider-style shoes (only acceptable options are Sperry Koifish in Linen Oat and Intrepid in Dark Tan).
- Merrell Jungle Moc Nubuck
- Shoelaces must only be black, brown or white and must be tied at all times.
- All shoes must have scuff-proof soles.

If a student is unable to wear the standard school uniform shoes (saddle oxfords, penny loafers, or dress lace-up shoes) due to a medical condition, the student must wear all-black athletic shoes, including the sole. Any medically necessary adjustment to the school uniform must be prescribed in writing by an appropriate physician, with a medical diagnosis and specific required duration. A note from a parent isn't acceptable. This doctor's note must be on file with the school nurse. If a student needs this accommodation for more than one school year, a new doctor's note is required at the beginning of each new school year.
