Hello Burroughs Families, welcome to the 2025-2026 school year!

Registration / Orientation begins Wednesday, July 30, 2025. Please read below for important information and updates.

Data confirmation assistance will be available from 8:30am-11:30am in the College and Career Center Wednesday July 30 - Monday, August 4, excluding Saturday and Sunday.

REGISTRATION DATES AND TIMES:

Senior Registration: Wednesday, July 30 from 8:30am-12:00pm (last entrance at 11:30am)

Junior Registration: Thursday, July 31 from 8:30am-12:00pm (last entrance at 11:30am)

Sophomore Registration: Friday, August 1 from 8:30am-12:00pm (last entrance at 11:30am)

Freshmen Orientation: Monday, August 4 from 8:30am-12:00pm (last entrance at 11:30am)

Make Up Registration: Wednesday, August 6 from 9:00am-12:00pm

During Registration, students will receive their schedules, lunch passes (if they have already applied and been approved), textbooks, available student store items, and be able to see their counselor (please read below for reasons why a student can see their counselor). Lunch pass and parking pass applications will be available to pick up. See Ms. Sierra in Student Services.

Due to the roof construction on campus, orientation will look slightly different this year!

- All student will start at **Station # 1**, Data Confirmation Table. This station will be located in front of school near the main stairs at the main Entrance. All families will need to complete the Data Confirmation on the Aeries parent portal prior to orientation. If the data confirmation is not complete, students will not be able to continue with registration.
- **Station # 2** is the form collection table.
- **Station # 3** is the Locator Card pick up table, also in front of school.
- **Station # 4** is the "See Counselor" line. This line will start at Parish Gate # 1, with the line traveling down Parish towards Clark Avenue.

- **Station # 5** is the Text Book Pick Up line. This line will start at Parish Gate # 1, with the line traveling down parish towards Verdugo Avenue.

REMINDER, WHAT HAS CHANGED:

BUSD is experiencing significant budget constraints for 2025-2026 that will affect the number of classes at JBHS. This means we will no longer be able to have the flexibility with schedule changes that we have enjoyed in the past.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

During registration and the first two weeks of school, you will likely not be able to change your classes based on preference.

IMPORTANT: AT REGISTRATION, STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO SEE COUNSELORS TO MAKE CHANGES FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS ONLY*:**

- You have SEE COUNSELOR on your schedule for period 8. If you see this on your schedule, you must come to the counseling office.

- You have a schedule conflict: ex. missing an elective, you have 2 period 2's, have the wrong math level, etc.
- You would like to change the start time of your school day (ex. period 0, period 1).
- You would like to DROP a program or a class with a special roster (i.e. choir, ASB, yearbook, etc.)
- You would like to ADD or DROP an AP or Honors course*
 - **NOT* all AP courses will be available

- You are a senior and you would like to be a TA*
 - **No* guarantees. You will need to get the form signed by an AVAILABLE teacher prior to getting a schedule change during the first week of school.
