## CARE/CID - SORENSEN

Please send the following supplies with your child, if you are able, within the first two weeks. It is likely that your child will not need all items on the general ed classroom supply list, but you may purchase them as you see fit. Please do not buy items twice if it is on both lists – we will share between classrooms! This list contains the main items your child will use and need within our special ed classroom.

- **1 standard size backpack**
- **1 small plastic pencil box**
- **4-6 Gluesticks** – We prefer the '**Disappearing Purple**' glue sticks that appear colored on the paper when wet and clear when dry. The colored glue is a great visual support for students when we complete activities! The Larger size is great for students with delays in fine motor skills too ☺
- **Glue** – 1 bottle of standard liquid glue (the purple glue is great but white is also fine)
- **1 pack of crayons** - basic colors are fine (you may choose to purchase the Jumbo/Large Crayons if you feel it will benefit your child due to fine motor delays)
- **1 pack large Markers** – (not the skinny kind) – a standard 8-9 color set
- **1 set watercolor paints**
- **2 highlighters** - yellow preferred
- **1-2 pocket folders** - (please label these with your child's name)
- **Facial Tissue/Kleenex**

*\*Please do not buy anything scented (i.e. markers, gluesticks, etc.) - while these items are more "fun" than the usual ones, they are often a huge distraction for students or encourage them to attempt eating these non-edible objects\**

- **Personal items** for your child as appropriate (pull-ups/wipes). We will inform you when our supply runs low. Every student will take 3 scheduled bathroom breaks each day, and additional breaks as needed.
  - Please send **two full changes of clothes** (including socks and underwear if appropriate) for your child in case of spills, accidents, or when the playground is extra wet.
- **Tennis Shoes** – (NON-MARKING) to participate appropriately and safely in gym class. You may send a pair to keep at school if that is most convenient, or you can have a pair travel between home and school each day.

Optional Items (if you are able)

- **Disinfectant wipes** – intended for surfaces, such as Clorox or Lysol wipes
- **Hand/Face wipes** (such as Wet Ones)
- **Hand sanitizer**
- **Corded Headphones**
