L&N STEM Academy is the state of Tennessee's only regional public high school.

L&N STEM serves grades 9-12 and operates on an alternating block schedule. Most classes meet Tuesday/Thursday or Wednesday/Friday. classes meeting three days per week will add Mondays.

School begins at 9:30 a.m. and releases at 4:30 p.m. every day, except on Mondays when school ends at 3:30 p.m. and on early release days when school ends at 1:30 p.m.

ACADEMICS

L&N STEM Academy gives students the opportunity to earn college credit by offering a number of Advanced Placement (AP) and Industry Certification (NIC) classes. Course offerings are listed below.

<u>AP classes</u> are high school courses that follow a rigorous college-level curriculum for which students can earn high school credit; they may also earn college credits with a qualifying score on an optional final exam.

NIC classes enable students to earn industry or occupational certifications based on specific standards that demonstrate skills providing a direct and efficient pathway to a career.
